INTRODUCTION

Shri Kshetra Dharmasthala is not only a great pilgrimage centre of South India but also a unique embodiment of Dharma. It represents religious tolerance wherein the caste, creed and faith of pilgrims is no bar. The temple complex is also known for its 'Annadana', 'Vidyadana', 'Abhayadhana', 'Aushadhadana', Rural Development and Social Service.

Rev. Dr. D. Veerendra Heggade succeeded to the Heggade ship in 1968. Since then the activities of the Kshetra and Shri Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwara Educational Trust has increased commendably. Shri Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwara Law College, Mangaluru, is one of the varied educational institutions run by the society. The Law College was started in the year 1974 under the Mysore University and in 1980, the college was affiliated to Mangalore University, thereafter from the academic year 2009-10 affiliated to the Karnataka State Law University, Hubballi and recognised by Bar Council of India, New Delhi. In the year 2011 the College is recognised as Research Centre by KSLU, Hubballi.

THE COLLEGE AND ITS LOCATION

The S.D.M. Law College is situated in the urban surroundings of Mangaluru along the Mahathma Gandhi Road, Kodialbail. The College is provided with a magnificent building, a wellknown splendour of the city. Besides, it contains all requirements including a fully equipped Court cum Seminar Hall, a good Library, a spacious Auditorium and large airy class rooms.

RULES & REGULATIONS :

1. Students are required to maintain the highest standard of behaviour and discipline both inside and outside the college.
2. They shall strictly observe the disciplinary rules framed by the college or which may be framed from time to time. Non Compliance of these rules will be dealt by the Principal in the manner he considers fit and his decision will be final in such matters.
3. Every student shall treat the staff members with utmost respect and dignity.
4. No student shall enter the class or leave the class without the permission of the Lecturer.
5. Students having no classes shall not loiter in the verandah but are expected to spend the time in the library.
6. Every class is in-charge of a mentor who keeps a close watch on the student's attendance, progress and conduct and looks after their general welfare.
7. Irregular attendance, indifference in regard to class work tests and examination, discourtesy towards the teachers insubordination, obscenity in work and act, willful damage of college property, anti social activities etc., are liable for disciplinary action which include expulsion from the college.
8. Attendance to the College functions, Association Meetings, College Assembly, Court Visit, Viva Voce, Sports Meet etc., are obligatory to all students. Failure which appropriate action will be taken.
9. The college property shall be handled with care and nothing shall be done to damage it. In case of damage to any building, furniture, apparatus or any other property of the College, the damage will be charged to the student or students known to be immediately concerned, but if the persons who caused the damage are unknown the cost of repairing it may be collected equally from the students in the college/class.
10. Students must keep the class rooms and college premises clean and writing in the black-board, walls, affixing posters on the walls are strictly prohibited.
11. Without the permission of the Principal, Students shall not organise any activities or associate with any group not concerned with the college or Political organization.
12. No meeting shall be convened, no person shall be invited to address the students, no publication shall be issued and no canvassing or mobilizing the students for any particular opinion or action will be allowed without the permission of the Principal.

13. Participation in political agitation, or demonstrations or strike of any kind is strictly prohibited.
14. Every student should possess an identify card issued by the college which should be produced whenever asked for, specially when dealing with the office and library.
15. Books, Bags etc., should have name or mark by which the owner can be easily known. Any unclaimed property should be brought to the principal's office.
16. Students are expected to be simple and modest in their dress and to follow the dress code prescribed by college strictly and to refrain from the use of tobacco, alcohol and drugs.
17. Students may not give the college address for any personal correspondence. The college will not be held responsible for the loss of any letter, whatever be the nature of the correspondence. Letters to the Principal should be accompanied by reply postage whenever posted and reply is desired.
18. No student should organize any Tour, Picnics or any meeting of College students either in the college or outside the college, without the permission of the Principal.
19. Boycotting classes, shouting slogans, obstructing fellow student to enter the classes will be viewed seriously.
20. Student who is found to have committed any act of indiscipline liable to any of the punishments i) Warning ii) Censure iii) Fine iv) Cancellation of Scholarships/ Free ships etc., v) Recovery in part or full for the loss or damages to the College property or property of others caused by the delinquent students. vi) Removal, rustication or expulsion from the college vii) With holding of certificate.
21. Grant of admission to current students seeking admission to successive years is subject to review of their conduct in the College during the previous year by the Principal of the College.
22. Students are not allowed to bring mobile phones or costly materials inside the premises of the College. If lost the College authorities are not responsible.
23. Ragging in any form amounts to a serious offence punishable both under IPC and Expulsion of the student from the college.
The punishments is to be inflicted summarily at the discretion of Principal whose decision will be final.
24. Any grievances against the college or university should go through proper channel with the knowledge of principal.

25. Students cannot air or mail their grievances against a teacher and any complaint should be in the written form and enquiry will be conducted and decision will be taken by the Principal.
26. **Students are not permitted to get up and go in the middle during college functions.**
27. Every student is bound to know the vision and mission of the college.
28. Every student should wear College Uniform regularly except on Saturdays. On all academic programmes/University exams Uniform is compulsory. Deviation for the first time dealt with the penalty of Rs.50 and for subsequent default the college may take any action as it may deserved to be fit
29. The students must carry their college identity card / library membership card with them whenever they go to library. They should show the identity card compulsorily at the time of issuing books and whenever asked by the library staff.

Admissions are made only for the current academic year on the clear understanding that they have to follow the rules and regulations in force in the college. A student who violates the regulations, will not be continued in the college for the next academic year.

LIBRARY INSTRUCTIONS

- ❖ Students are required to deposit their belongings at the property counter at their own risk. The library/College is not responsible for any loss or damage to the same.
- ❖ Bringing of bags, files and personal books into the library is strictly prohibited. Use of mobile phones in and around the library is strictly prohibited.
- ❖ Keeping in mind that the Library is a place of individual study and research, students should maintain an atmosphere of dignity, peace and silence within the library premises.
- ❖ Students should not sub-lend the books and other documents borrowed from the library. Library documents should be handled with utmost care. Writing, marking, making any note on them or any damage is strictly prohibited.
- ❖ Group discussion not allowed in the library, but the students are allowed to have the group discussion in the class room with prior permission and students are permitted to take the library books on their identity card.

PROMOTION

1. The student must have attended a minimum of 70% classes conducted in the semester. *
2. The student shall have paid the examination fees and submitted the applications to the University for both semesters of the academic year.*
3. Minimum Two subjects should completed in each academic year. (i.e. 2 semesters)*

*** No student shall be promoted to next academic year unless above provisions are fulfilled.**

4. Students are required to successfully complete the entire course within Eight years for (3 years) and 10 Years for (5 years) from admission to the course.

AWARD OF THE DEGREE

A student shall be eligible for the award of the LL.B. Degree after he/she has successfully completed all the prescribed courses in all the semesters and has secured a minimum of 40% in the aggregate provided his or her character and conduct are found to be satisfactory during the course.

AWARD OF CLASSES

The award of classes shall be as under:

- a) 70% and more First Class with Distinction
- b) 60% and above but less than 70% First Class
- c) 50% and above but less than 60% Second Class
- d) 40% and above but less than 50% Pass Class

Introduction

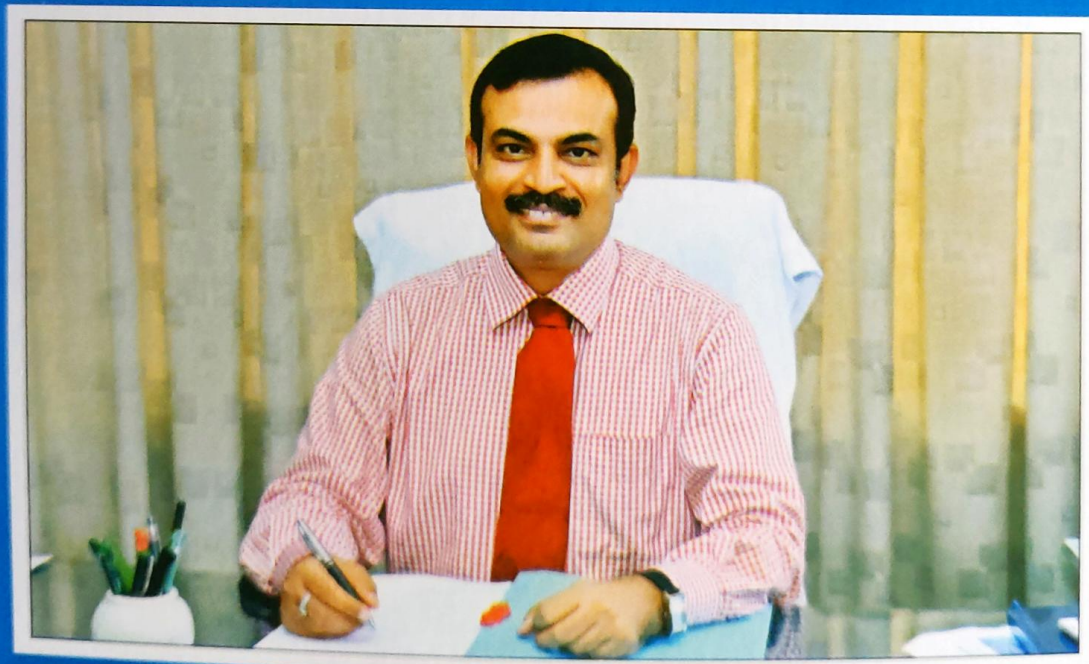
