Dr Shashikala Gurpur, Dean of Symbiosis Law college Pune, inaugurated the National Conference on 'A Discourse on Medical Termination of Pregnancy'. 10:30 am - 11:30 am	Dr.M.P.Chengappa Assistant Professor (Law) The WB National University of Judicial Sciences	Is the MTP Act against the physical anatomy of women?

Dr.M.P.Chengappa discussed a landmark Judgment in Justice K.S.Puttaswamy V. Union of India wherein Right to Privacy was discussed as a fundamental right. He also elaborated on the evolution of Right to life of Fetus in the Indian scenario. He explained the legal fiction so as to rights of a fetus. Dr.M.P.Chengappa further spoke on Rights of a Woman with regards to the Rights of an unborn child .He also mentioned the offences against an unborn child. He elaborated on the objectives of MTP Act and its provisions so as to when the abortion is legal .

Dr.M.P.Chengappa Sir Concluded the Session by marking out the need to balance the fundamental shift in power from doctor to the woman, ensure institutional health care faculty protocol. He emphasized on the need to decide abortion cases in the light of liberty, freedom and dignity of woman.

The session was followed by a 'Q& A' session where he addressed various doubts by the participants. The session was indeed a learning a learning experience, broadening the knowledge of the participants on MTP Act and how it affects physical anatomy of women.

Dr. Deepa Kanagal V., Professor and Departmentu of OBG ,Father Muller Medical College,Mangaluru discussed on the induction of abortion. She mentioned the dilemma faced by women regarding termination of pregnancy. She also elaborated on the complexity pertaining to termination of pregnancy. She further discussed several case studies on the subject. She also discussed the case Roe V. Wade (1973) and the case of Savitha Halappanavar. He elaborated on various provisions of MTP Act .She mentioned the various indications that allows a woman to terminate the pregnancy.

Dr. Deepa Kanagal V. also spoke on the problems faced due to unavailability of qualified healthcare providers to terminate pregnancy. She pointed out the issues relating to abortion laws in India. She concluded the her talk stating the actual test of the amendments is to implement it to close access gaps and other areas of improvement..She emphasised the need to develop a progressive attitude surrounding abortion in India.

The session was then followed by a 'Q & A' session where students clarified several doubts on the subject. It was indeed an enlightening session by Dr. Deepa Kanagal V. on the topic which showed a different perspective towards the termination of pregnancy ,it's complications ,issues relating to implementation of law.

Dr. G Rajashekar, Assistant Professor, Department of Legal Studies, University of Madras in his session spoke regarding the Right of an Unborn child and the Father in India. Sir pointed out that The Doctor's take an Oath before beginning their career which is ought to be followed by them till the end. Sir expressed that Even the foetus is a Human organism and it has a Right to life. Sir also mentioned that in the MTP ACT,1971 the fundamental reproductive health of the women was the main concern. Dr. G Rajashekar mentioned that Additional Protocols to the Geneva Conventions include in their judicial guarantees that "the death penalty shall not be pronounced on pregnant women or mothers of young children". Also, in the draft declaration of Geneva Convention, 1950 it was said that unborn child is similar to a child who is born and it is entitled to grow in health. It also included that there will be conflict of interest when it comes to Right of the father.

The session was followed by 'question and answer session where he addressed various questions and doubts of the students. It was indeed an excellent learning experience, broadening the knowledge of students on the particular subject.

Dr. A David Ambrose, Professor and Head (Rtd) Dean, Legal Affairs (Rtd) Department of Legal Studies, University of Madras in his session spoke regarding the Legal and Ethical dimensions of MTP act. Sir mentioned that Earlier abortion has been permitted to save the life of the mother but Now abortions are permitted when the mother's life is not only threat but continued pregnancy will cause damage to her mental and physical health. Sir pointed out that, The impact of the MTP Act should be judged in the context of changing social values and attitudes and not just based on laws. Sir urged the importance of universal access to sexual and reproductive health-care services, including for family planning, information and education, and the integration of reproductive health into national strategies and programmes in India.

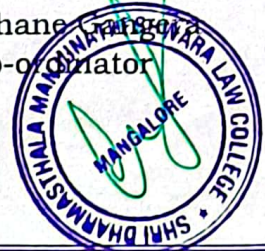

About the College

Dharmasthala is a famous temple town on the bank of river Nethravathi with a magnificent backdrop of western Ghats. The place is known for its religious sanctity and religious harmony. Shri Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwara Law College, Centre for Post-Graduate Studies and Research in Law is a professional college functioning under the aegis of SDM Educational Society, Ujire. The college was established in the year 1974. Since its inception, the college is striving for innovative methods in imparting legal education. About the Conference

The Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act (MTP Act) recognizes the rights of the woman who wishes to undergo the termination of her pregnancy. Under the Act, the permissible ground of medical termination depends upon the mental and physical health of the woman. The MTP Act, applies to all women regardless of their marital status and therefore the term "pregnant woman" or "pregnancy" is used which does not indicate the marital status of the pregnant woman. The MTP Act 1971 allowed for the termination of pregnancy up to 12 weeks and in emergency cases, up to 20 weeks. Abortifacient



can now be performed until 24 weeks of pregnancy (only in exceptional cases) as per the MTP Amendment Act 2021. A woman's right to make reproductive choices is also a dimension of personal liberty as under Article 21 of the Constitution of India. It is important to recognize that reproductive choices can be exercised to procreate as well as to abstain from procreating and the crucial consideration is that a women's right to privacy, dignity, and bodily integrity should be respected.

When we talk regarding a woman's right in having or not to have a child, the rights of a man are ignored. Even though a woman is the one to bear the child, the man has equal right in having a say. It is unreasonable that, after fertilization has occurred women have several opportunities to legally opt out of pregnancy and parenthood; whereas men have none.

Another crucial point is that medical termination of pregnancy results in the death of a living being. The foetus's heart starts beating as early as 5-6 weeks. The Indian law speaks about the right to property of an unborn child. The fundamental question is: what is the right of an unborn child? Doesn't an unborn child have the right to life? As per Article 21 of the Indian Constitution, nobody has the right to take away any person's life except by the procedure of law, and hence, the unborn child deserves all the fundamental rights and he should be granted the "Right to life" as per "Article 21 of the Indian Constitution" similar to a normal person.

With this background the conference aims to address the following issues:

1. What are the legal aspects of a women's right to retain or terminate her pregnancy?
2. Whether the sole decision of a woman to terminate her pregnancy violates the rights of other stakeholders?
3. What are the ethical and legal dimensions of the MTP Act?
4. MTP Act and women's right to health.
