#### Report on National Seminar on "Comprehensive Analysis of Human Rights Relating to Children in India"

The one-day national seminar on "Comprehensive Analysis of Human Rights Relating to Children in India" was held on 12th February 2020 at 9:30 AM in the SDM Conference Hall. 


