# REGULATION GOVERNING CERTIFICATE COURSES PROGRAMME IN LAW

[Under Section 49(1) (c) of the Karnataka State Law University Act, 2009.]

## 01 TITLE

This Regulation may be called as "The Karnataka State Law University's Regulation Governing the Certificate Programme in Law".

#### 02 EXTENT

This Regulation extends to all Constituent University Law Colleges, Departments of Studies in Law, Schools of Law and all affiliated Law Colleges within the jurisdiction of the Karnataka State Law University which are accorded permission to start Certificate Courses.

#### 03 COMMENCEMENT

This Regulation shall come into force from the date of it's assent by the Chancellor.

#### **04 DEFINITIONS**

(1) In this Regulation, the expressions, "University", "University Area", "College", "Affiliated College", "Department", "Department of Studies", "Post Graduate Department", "Post Graduate Department of Studies", "Teachers", "University College" and "Principal" bear the same meanings as assigned under Section 2 of the Karnataka State Law University Act, 2009.

(2) Chairman/Director/Principal mean Chairman of the P.G. Department/Director of Law School or Principal of the Autonomous College/affiliated College.

The University can start any other certificate programme with an approval of the Academic Council and Syndicate.

#### 06. DURATION OF THE PROGRAMME

- (1) The duration of each certificate programme shall be six months.
- (2) The programme shall spread to sixteen weeks excluding examination days.

#### 07. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

The candidate shall possess 10+2/ PUC or equivalent or a degree from a University recognized by the University Grants Commission.

# 08. SCHEME OF THE CERTIFICATE PROGRAMME

- (1) Each Certificate course Programme shall consist of 2 papers of 100 marks each or 1 paper of 100 marks and 1 dissertation/project work of 100 marks which shall be subject to double valuation.
- (2) Each paper shall consist of 5 units.

#### 09. ATTENDANCE

- (1) No student shall be permitted to appear for the examination at the end of the Certificate Programme in a given course unless he/she has, to the satisfaction of the course teacher, fulfilled the course requirements and has put in not less than 75% attendance in the course attended.
  - Provided that a student who has attended not less than 65% of classes in each of the subjects prescribed may be permitted to keep the term for reasons to be recorded in writing and to the satisfaction of the Principal of the College/Director of Law School or Dean of the Faculty, as the case may be, subject to the penal fee of Rs.500 per paper, which shall be remitted to the University.
- (2) The student who does not possess the required attendance may take re-admission to the Certificate Programme.

#### 10. MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

Medium of instruction shall be either in English or in Kannada.

#### 11. EXAMINATION

The University shall conduct examination in one week after the completion of sixteen weeks of teaching.

#### 12. CONSTITUTION OF BOARD OF EXAMINERS

- (1) The Board of Examiners shall be constituted by the Board of Appointment of Examiners.
- (2) The Board of Examiners shall consist of a Chairman and four Members.
- (3) The Chairman and Members of the Board of Examiners shall be nominated on the basis of seniority list of teachers maintained in the University.

# 13. DUTIES OF THE BOARD OF EXAMINERS

- (1) The Chairman of the Board of Examiners shall appoint examiners and see that the question papers are prepared in time properly.
- (2) The Board of Examiners shall scrutinize and approve the question papers and hand it over to the Registrar (Evaluation).
- (3) The Chairman of the Board of Examiners shall appoint Examiners from the approved panel of Examiners.

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#### 14. VALUATION OF ANSWER SCRIPTS:

- (1) The approved Examiners shall evaluate the Answer Scripts.
- (2) The answer scripts shall be bar coded before they are given to the approved examiners for evaluation.
- (3) Photo copy/Re-totaling/Revaluation of a student's answer script shall be given on demand, subject to payment of fee prescribed from time to time.

## 15. CLASSIFICATION OF SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATES

- The minimum mark to pass in each paper (Theory and Practical/Skill Development put together) shall be 40%.
- (2) For declaration of First Class with Distinction/First Class/Second Class, the aggregate of the total marks secured by a candidate (including repeaters) in the course if put together shall be constitute as under:

70% and more First Class with Distinction

60% and above but less than 70% First Class

50% and above but less than 60% Second Class

40% and above but less than 50% Pass Class

- (1) Such candidates who have failed/remained absent and those who seek improvement in one or more theory papers in a course, sub candidates henceforth called as REPEATERS, and who shall appear for improvement in such paper/s during the two immediate successive examinations.
- (2) Such candidates who have discontinued the course of Certificate Programme, shall have to get admission themselves to the Programme in the calendar year of Programme.
- (3) If a candidate absents himself/herself from the practical/skill development examinations, the committee constituted (not exceeding 3 teachers of the department/college for that examination period, by the Head of the Institution) shall examine all the reasons for such absence, and if the committee is of the opinion that, the absence of the candidate is on valid grounds then, the committee may allow such candidate to appear for the practical/skill development examinations. A list of such candidates for whom permission is granted or rejected, with reasons shall be sent to the Registrar (Evaluation) before the commencement of such examinations.

# REGULATION GOVERNING CERTIFICATE COURSES PROGRAMME IN LAW

[Under Section 49(1) (c) of the Karnataka State Law University Act, 2009.]

## 01 TITLE

This Regulation may be called as "The Karnataka State Law University's Regulation Governing the Certificate Programme in Law".

#### 02 EXTENT

This Regulation extends to all Constituent University Law Colleges, Departments of Studies in Law, Schools of Law and all affiliated Law Colleges within the jurisdiction of the Karnataka State Law University which are accorded permission to start Certificate Courses.

#### 03 COMMENCEMENT

This Regulation shall come into force from the date of it's assent by the Chancellor.

#### 04 DEFINITIONS

(1) In this Regulation, the expressions, "University", "University Area", "College", "Affiliated College", "Department", "Department of Studies", "Post Graduate Department", "Post Graduate Department of Studies", "Teachers", "University College" and "Principal" bear the same meanings as assigned under Section 2 of the Karnataka State Law University Act, 2009.

(2) Chairman/Director/Principal mean Chairman of the P.G. Department/Director of Law School or Principal of the Autonomous College/affiliated College.

# 06. DURATION OF THE PROGRAMME

- (1) The duration of each certificate programme shall be six months.
- (2) The programme shall spread to sixteen weeks excluding examination days.

# 07. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

The candidate shall possess 10+2/ PUC or equivalent or a degree from a University recognized by the University Grants Commission.

# 08. SCHEME OF THE CERTIFICATE PROGRAMME

- Each Certificate course Programme shall consist of 2 papers of 100 marks each or 1 paper of 100 marks and 1 dissertation/project work of 100 marks which shall be subject to double valuation.
- (2) Each paper shall consist of 5 units.

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## 09. ATTENDANCE

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Provided that a student who has attended not less than 65% of classes in each of the subjects prescribed may be permitted to keep the term for reasons to be recorded in writing and to the satisfaction of the Principal of the College/Director of Law School or Dean of the Faculty, as the case may be, subject to the penal fee of Rs.500 per paper, which shall be remitted to the University.

(2) The student who does not possess the required attendance may take re-admission to the Certificate Programme.

# 10. MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

Medium of instruction shall be either in English or in Kannada.

#### 11. EXAMINATION

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The University shall conduct examination in one week after the completion of sixteen weeks of teaching.

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- The minimum mark to pass in each paper (Theory and Practical/Skill Development put together) shall be 40%.
- (2) For declaration of First Class with Distinction/First Class/Second Class, the aggregate of the total marks secured by a candidate (including repeaters) in the course if put together shall be constitute as under:

70% and more First Class with Distinction

60% and above but less than 70% First Class

50% and above but less than 60% Second Class

40% and above but less than 50% Pass Class

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## CERTIFICATE COURSE IN BACKGROUND AND LEGAL FRAMEWORK OF PARA-LEGAL SERVICES

**COURSE DURATION: 60 Hours** 

#### **COURSE OBJECTIVES:**

This course intends to develop a functional understanding of the Indian legal system and laws that affect individuals in day-to-day life. It aims to impart elementary skills of accessing grievance redressal institutions and their processes. The aim is to create a cadre of paralegal volunteers who would strengthen the legal aid delivery system by bridging the gap between people, especially the most vulnerable, and the legal system by embarking upon legal literacy programmes and facilitating access to justice. This course introduces the students to constitutional and statutory framework relating to legal system, legal aid, role and responsibilities of paralegal volunteers; also equip them with necessary drafting and other skills to be effective exponents of cause of justice and fill the role of paralegal volunteer effectively.

Course includes assignments like writing projects and courts visits, Lok Adalat, Mediation Centres, State and District Legal Services Authority etc.

#### UNIT-I

Law as an instrument of social change, law & social justice, legal interventions in poverty alleviation and gender equity. Constitution of India and its framework Preamble, fundamental rights, directive principles of state policy, state's obligation to provide free legal aid, fundamental duties, Public Interest Litigation (PIL), Introduction to Indian legal and Court system- Civil Courts, Criminal Courts, Higher Judiciary, Tribunals, Human Rights Commissions and Human Rights Courts.

#### UNIT - II

Remedial legislation in India with particular reference to the Right to Information Act, 2005. Protection of Civil Rights Act, 1955, Scheduled Castes and Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993, Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956, Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961, Law relating to protection of women and children again sexual abuse, Industrial Relations Code, 2020, Unorganised Workers Social Security Act 2008, Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, Mental Healthcare Act, 2017, Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007, the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.





#### EUROPEAN FOUNDATIONS OF THE IMAGE OF INDIA

COURSE DURATION: 40 hours

#### COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is a Jean Monnet module co-funded under the European Union's Erasmus Plus programme. At the broadest level the course basically examines how our understanding of India today is based on the way Europe saw India and the shape this perception took within Western-born Social Sciences. As a particular focus, this course takes up questions of how we look at caste and communalism today.
