

# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING


This binding Memorandum of Understanding signed on 16th June 2023 entered

This MOU gives general understanding and modalities governing the cooperation between the parties under this MOU.

### SCOPE

3. Both parties reserve the right to terminate this memorandum by either party by giving six months written notice to the other.


4. The implementation and/or continuance of programmes or projects established pursuant to this memorandum prior to the effective date of termination shall not be affected by the termination of his Memorandum.
