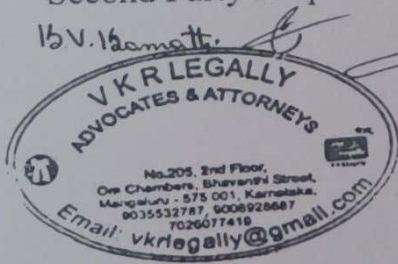

This MOU gives general understanding and modalities governing the co-operation between the parties under this MOU.

SCOPE

AGREEMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

2. The memorandum may be amended at any time by mutual consent and in writing.
3. Both parties reserve the right to terminate this memorandum by either party by giving six months written notice to the other.
4. The implementation and/or continuance of programmes or projects established pursuant to this memorandum prior to the effective date of termination shall not be affected by the termination of his Memorandum.

TERMINATION TERMS:

1. This Memorandum shall come into force immediately upon its signature by the parties.
2. The validity of this Memorandum of Understanding is initially for a period of five years from the date of its execution and the same can be further extended on mutual agreement.
3. This Memorandum of Understanding can be terminated by either of the parties by giving advance notice of six months.
