Each party shall designate a person or office to serve as liaison for implementing the projects undertaken as per this Agreement.

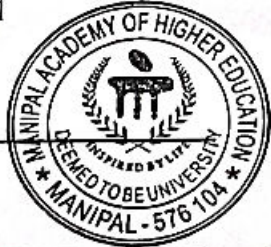

- UNIABROAD agrees to provide marketing materials like enquiry forms, brochures, Flyers, Standees as per SDMLC requirement with Zero Cost.
- UNIABROAD agrees to provide Training for SDMLC Staff at no cost.



(3) Reporting

Once a year, in the month of May, the whole process shall be reviewed by UNIABROAD's Relationship Manager.

(4) Indemnification
