### **1. Report on Green Campus Initiatives**

The college has proactively implemented the "Embracing Eco-friendly and Energy-saving Solutions" policy to foster a culture of resource conservation among students and faculty. This comprehensive policy emphasizes reducing plastic usage and promoting the principles of reducing, reusing, and recycling, alongside encouraging energy-saving practices. To further support these goals, the college has installed boards to limit the entry of four-wheeled automobiles for students, thereby mitigating carbon emissions and alleviating traffic congestion. Given the college's central location within the city, both students and faculty are encouraged to use public transportation, which is readily accessible.

Additionally, the college campus is designed with pedestrian-friendly pathways, making it easy for faculty members and students from nearby hostels and residences to walk to campus. Strategically placed boards around the campus raise awareness about the ban on plastic usage, environmental protection, and the importance of avoiding littering. The campus itself features a well-maintained garden with a fishpond and trees, contributing to a green and serene environment.

To further reduce energy consumption, the college has adopted the use of LED tubes, and solar lights which are more energy-efficient and sustainable. Embracing modern communication methods, the college utilizes official WhatsApp groups for staff, Telegram channels for students, and email communication to minimize paper usage. Study materials are distributed through Google Classroom, Google Drive, and email to reduce the need for photocopying, further decreasing paper usage. The Management also provides EERPMS software for uploading attendance details, student data, leave applications, and study materials.

The Eco-Club plays a pivotal role in promoting eco-friendly practices. It organized a walkathon to advocate for the adoption of electric vehicles and commemorates 'Environment Day' with student lectures and
