Overview of the case

In the case the petitioner-1 had filed a case against the petitioner-2 for claiming maintenance.

Questions asked by the presiding officer.

Presiding officer: What is your name?

Petitioner 1: Rajeswari.

Presiding officer: What is your educational qualification.

Petitioner-1: 10th Pass.

Presiding officer: Do you have children?

Petitioner-1: yes, 2.

Presiding officer: What do the children do?

Petitioner 1: They go to college.

Presiding officer: Do they stay together.

Petitioner 1: yes.

Presiding officer: Does he give maintenance.

Petitioner 1: yes.

Presiding officer: Do you want to think about the matter?





Provisions:

Section 13-B :- Divorce by mutual consent.

- (1) Subject to the provisions of this Act a petition for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce may be presented to the district court by both the parties to a marriage together, whether the marriage was solemnized before or after the commencement of the Marriage Laws, (Amendment) Act, 1976 (68 of 1976), on the ground that they have been living separately for a period of one year or more, that they have not been able to live together and that they have mutually agreed that the marriage should be dissolved.
- (2) On the motion of both the parties made not earlier than six months after the date of presentation of the petition referred to in sub-section (1) and not later than eighteen months after the said date, if the petition is not withdrawn in the meantime, the court shall, on being satisfied, after hearing the parties, and after making such inquiries as it thinks fit, that the marriage has been solemnized and that the averments in the petition are true, pass a decree of divorce, declaring the marriage has been dissolved with effect from the date of decree.
- (3) The period of 6 to 18 months provided in section 13B is a period of interregnum which is intended to give time and opportunity to the parties to reflect on their move. In this transitional

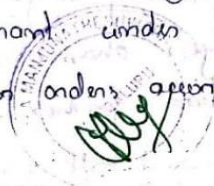

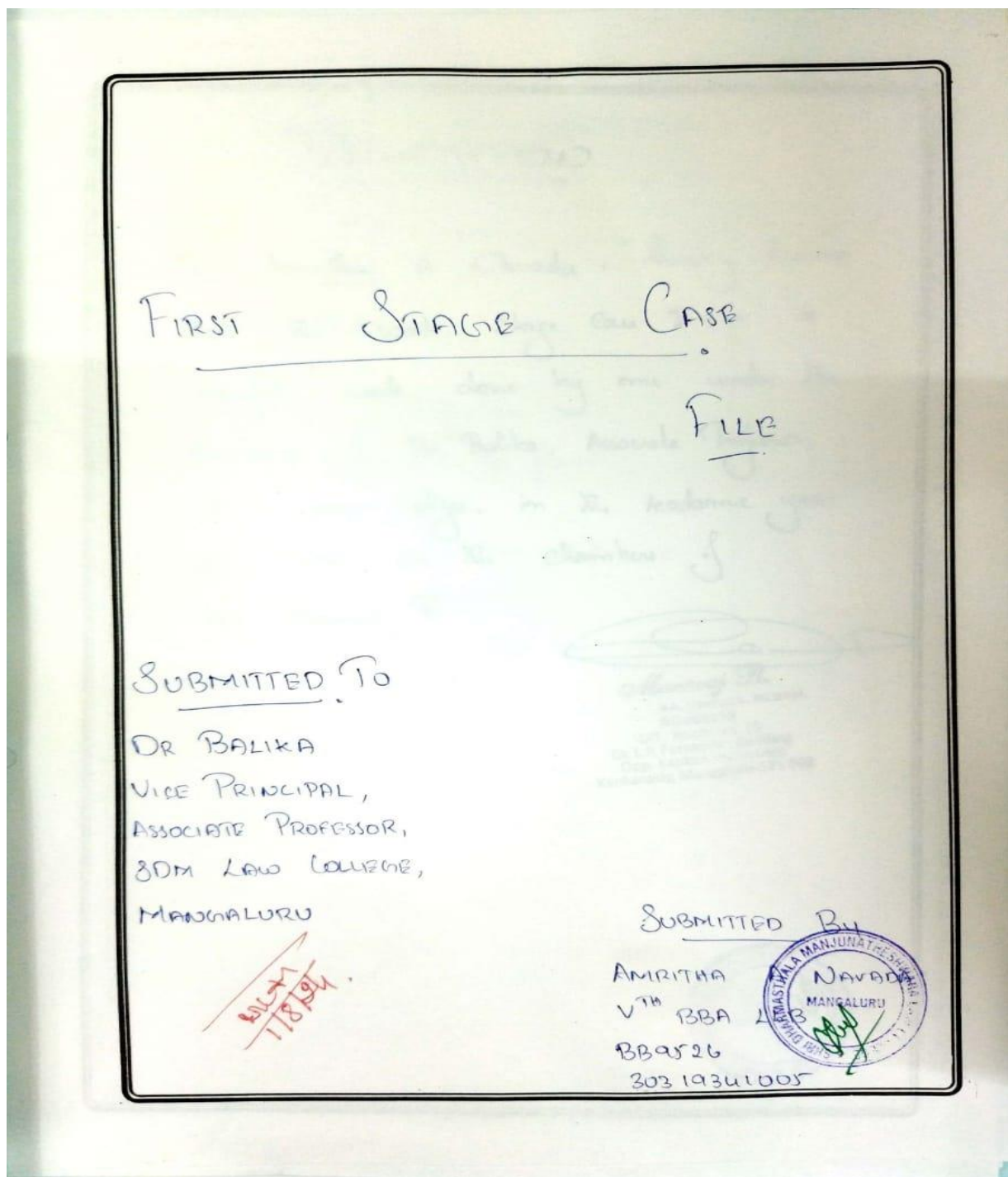

FACTS OF THE CASE

On 13th September 2017, between 0030 hours and 0400 hours at kumarimel House, Pookatiparambu, Paolanur bearing No. xv1/28 of kuthamun Grama Panchayat, in the ownership of deceased Sri Swaminathan, in pursuance of common intention and criminal conspiracy hatched by accused 1 & 2 for the purpose of killing both Sri Swaminathan and his wife Smt. Premakumari and as abetted by the second accused, the first accused entered into the above residential building and committed murder of Sri Swaminathan and Smt. Premakumari by stabbing with a chopper and also hitting with a hammer. True after the accused have also committed theft of ₹23,000/- (Rupees twenty three thousand) and gold ornaments kept in the jewel box.

The incident was first noticed by Smt Rajalakshmi who was a regular to the house at 6 AM, where she found the door open where the second accused was found lying on the corridor. She informed Chandram, the brother of the deceased who found the dead bodies and the second accused distraught, who was shifted to the District Hospital and later to the Government Medical College hospital. FIR statement was given and the night was recorded at 10:55 AM on 13.09.2017.

5am, the first accused on the basis of tip received, arrested and taken into police custody from 8th Mile bus stop. On interrogations it was found that he was involved in the crime. On the basis of various articles found & incriminating evidence found him and the statement given by him to the police the involvement of the second accused was found and she was arrested on the same day at 5 P.M.

Both the accused ~~was~~ have tried to destroy the evidence by sprinkling chilly powder inside the house & on the dead bodies of the deceased, by putting the weapons and allied materials in a well and also the second accused voluntarily giving her gold ornaments to the first accused. ① Under trial prisoners were all who were accused in various criminal cases but have not been convicted or acquitted. Their trial proceedings are going on.

② The convicted persons were kept in the central prison. They are serving their sentence on various cases.

③ Open air prisons are those available at a few which allows for more open time for the prisoners.

The Mangalore District prison enables for the reformed system for under trial prisoners with both men & women being kept at the same complex with amenities available

3. Sandhya Sunaksha Yojana: Citizens above the age of 65 years are eligible for to receive a payment upto ₹ 1,200/- per month.

4. Rastriya Kumbha Neruvare Yojana: It is one in a life time scheme available to those between the age limit of 18-60 years.

5. Monaswimi Yojana: Scheme provided for unmarried women above the age of 40 years for a payment upto ₹ 800/- per month.

6. Angal: katha vedana Scheme: Provided for the differently abled the schemes is available to those who have been dependant on others for their sustenance. they on proof of documents necessary with percentage of handicap are eligible for a payment between ₹ 1400 - ₹ 2,000/- per month.





7. widow and acid attack scheme:- . They are availed by those widows whose husbands died due to suicide and those victims who were attacked by acid for a payment upto ₹10,000/- per month.

INTRODUCTION

Conciliation is an alternative dispute resolution (ADR) process where parties in a dispute seek to resolve their issues with the help of a neutral third party known as the conciliator. The conciliator's role is to facilitate communication between the disputing parties, identify the issues, and help them reach a mutually acceptable agreement. Unlike arbitration or litigation, the conciliator does not impose a decision on the parties. Instead, the process is more collaborative and flexible, aiming for a win-win outcome.

Conciliation is often seen as less adversarial and more cost-effective than traditional legal processes, making it a popular choice for resolving both commercial and personal disputes.

We have performed evaluative conciliation, in which the conciliator assesses the merits of each party's cases and suggests possible settlement options based on this evaluation.

FACTS OF THE CASE

Mr. Shekhar, a software Engineer, was working in a computer software company (hereafter the company) in Bangalore. He was originally from a village in Tamil Nadu and studied at a government engineering college in Tamil Nadu. Through campus placement, he was selected for this job. As per the company's policy, he had to sign a bond to serve the company for a minimum of 5 years failing which he would have to pay 5 Lakhs. This condition was imposed because, once an employee joins, the company provides 6 months of in-house training to each employee free of cost. After receiving the training, he/she was expected to serve the company for at least 5 years. Additionally, all his original educational and professional certificates were taken by the company at the time of joining. Mr. Shekhar now wanted to resign after completing 3 years of services but was not willing to pay the bond amount. The company refused to hand over the original certificates, claiming the right to retain them until the bond amount was paid. In the meantime, the received very good proposal to tie up with a corporation. Mr. Shekhar urgently needed his certificates, and the company also wanted to

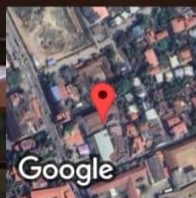

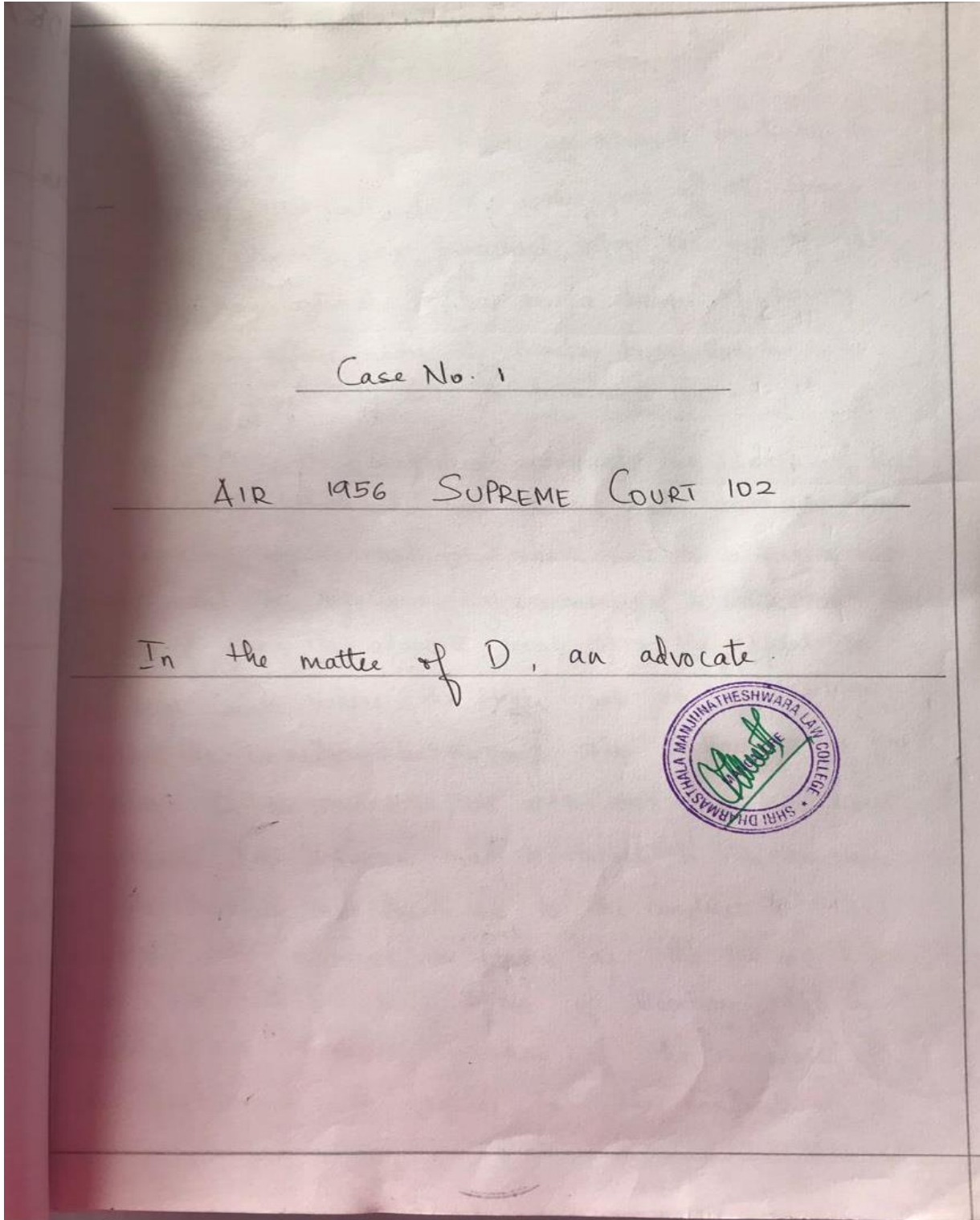

FACTS OF THE CASE :

D, the respondent is an advocate practicing in the Bombay High Court. In the earlier part of the year 1953, the advocate was prosecuted before the one of the presidency magistrates at Bombay on a charge of having committed an offence under the Bombay Prohibition Act. The trial lasted from July 1953 to November 1953.

On 15-11-1953, the Magistrate convicted the advocate of the offence with which he was charged and sentenced him to rigorous imprisonment for 1 month and to a fine of £201/- and to rigorous imprisonment of 4 weeks on default of fine. The advocate went upon the appeal to the High Court where the High Court on 24-02-1954 upheld the conviction but altered the sentence to one fine of £100. In the meantime, on 25-11-1953, the trial court magistrate Mr. Sonavane made a report to the registrar of the Bombay High Court as to the conduct of the advocate who appeared in person as the accused before him. The Hon'ble Chief Justice of Bombay High constituted a tribunal consisting of the members of the Bar Council to enquire into the conduct of the

advocates on 16-03-1955. The respondent advocate pleaded
guilty to the charges levelled against him.
The tribunal made a report to the High Court where held
on the respondent's own administration the allegation in
the report Mr. Sonavane to be proved and recommended
that a very serious note should be taken of the
respondent's conduct.
Finally, the respondent advocate forwarded a copy of the
letter to the secretary of the Bar Council tribunal under
which was addressed by him to the registrar of Bombay
High Court and requested the tribunal to accept his apology
for delaying the proceedings before the tribunal.
In the letter to the Registrar, the advocate attached
a separate letter in which he tendered his uncondi-
tional apology, wishing to withdraw his contentions that the
proceedings before the tribunal were misconceived. He further
admitted that High Court had full authority to refer
the matter to the tribunal. The advocate stated in his
letter that the statement made by Mr. Sonavane
was true (regarding the advocate's conduct in the magistrate
request). The tribunal submitted its final report to the
High Court and recommended that it should take a
very serious note regarding the advocate's conduct.



After going through the aspects, the High Court issued notice to the advocate for final hearing. He pleaded through his counsel to be let off with a mere warning. But the High Court decided to suspend him for 1 year from the date of order.

ISSUE:

- 1) Do whether the conduct of the advocate amounts to contempt?
- 2) Whether the High Court has jurisdiction to try the advocate for contempt under the Bombay Prohibition Act?

REASON FOR JUDGEMENT:

The conduct of the advocate in the criminal trial against him in the court of the magistrate was entirely indistinguishable by any standard. It disclosed a continuous persistent attempt on the part of the advocate to be rude to and contemptuous of the magistrate to hold up the trial and to do everything in his power to bring the administration of justice into contempt, so as conduct merits were condemnation. The advocate should by reason of his having indulged in conduct unworthy of the member of the honourable profession to

Duties of an Advocate towards client:

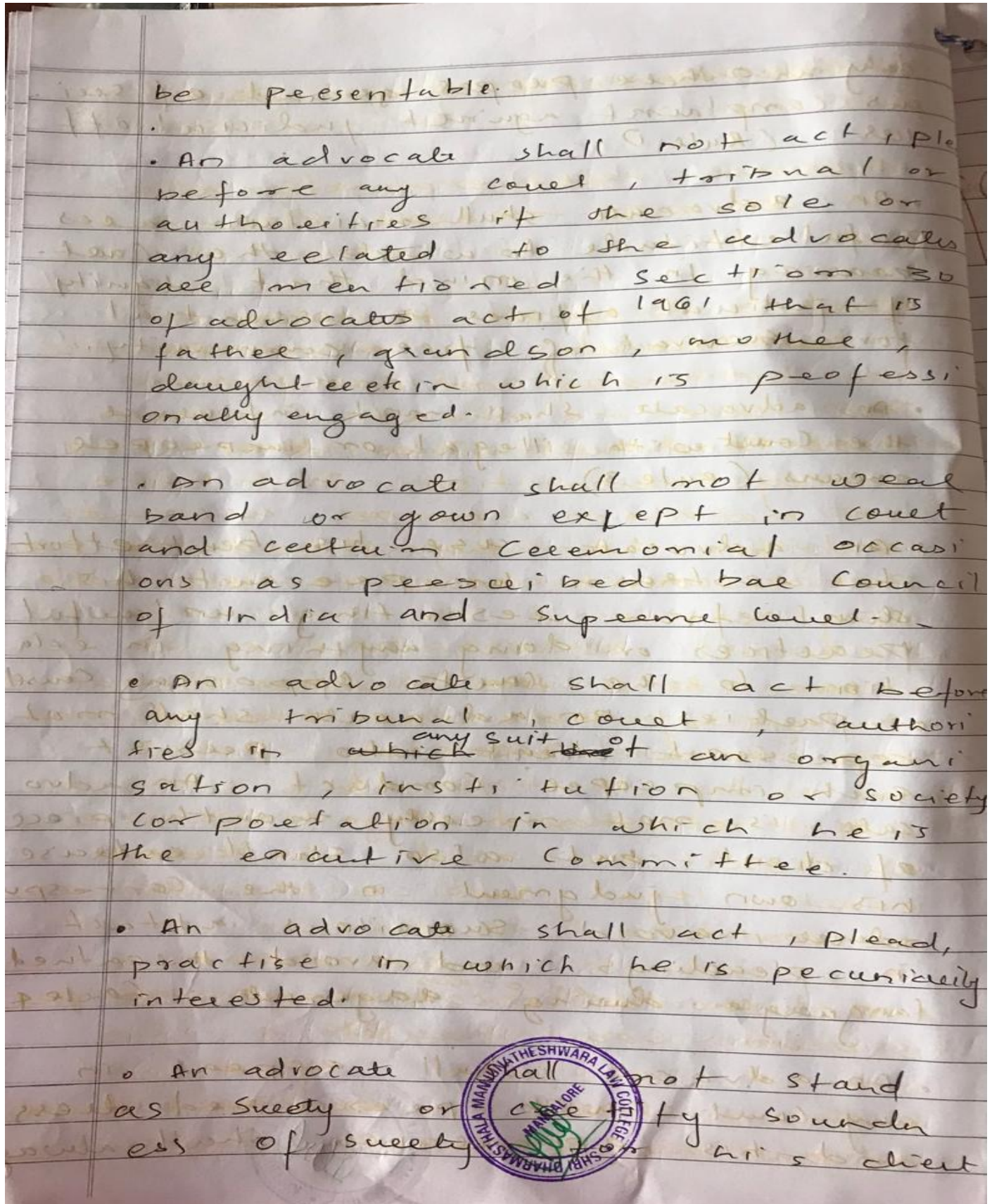

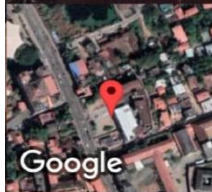




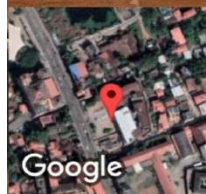
