3. Approval of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, dtd: 21.08.2018.

With reference to the above subject, this is to inform the Principals of all Affiliated Law Colleges of KSLU that, unless otherwise provided for in each course carrying 100 marks, 20 marks shall be awarded by way of internal assessment. The end of the semester examination shall be conducted for 80 marks. A student should secure a minimum of 40% of the marks in the end semester examination to be declared as pass in that paper provided, he has secured a minimum of 40 marks in that paper along with internal assessment marks. That is, a student has to secure a minimum of 32 marks in each paper in the end semester examination. These 20 marks shall be awarded as per the modalities below:

Modalities for Awarding Internal Assessment Marks

1. The 20 marks for internal assessment shall be apportioned as under.
 - a. One test- 10 marks
 - b. Assignment- 5 marks
 - c. Seminar based on assignments- 5 marks
2. The test shall be conducted in the 10th week of the semester.
3. The student shall write one essay answer for 7 marks and one short note/ problem for 3 marks.
4. The test shall be for one hour.
5. There shall be two essay type questions of which student shall answer one and two short note questions of which students shall answer one.
6. Topics for assignments shall be based on the syllabus prescribed for the course. The course teachers shall allocate topics to students in the second week of the semester. The assignment may be in the form of a statute analysis, case comment, essay, research on a topic or a socio-legal survey. It shall be in the hand writing of the student and he/ she

should make a declaration to the effect that it is his/ her original work. The assignment shall be of 15 pages excluding preliminary pages.

7. The test papers and assignment shall be maintained by the college systematically for inspection by the University.
8. There shall be no provision for improvement/ attempt. Students have to fulfill the requirements in the same semester in the same batch.
9. Students remaining absent on medical grounds may be given a chance to take the internal assessment exercises by the Principal. Proper records shall be maintained in this regard.
10. Coordination Committee:
 - a. The Coordination Committees constituted by the University shall review the marks allotted by the course teacher.
 - b. The committee shall inspect the marks awarded to various components and make out if objective standards are followed in awarding marks.
 - c. It shall have the power to vary up to 5% of the marks awarded.
 - d. In case the awarding of marks is found to be arbitrary, the same shall be reported to the University, which shall be considered by a committee constituted by the Vice Chancellor, which shall submit its report to the Vice Chancellor. The decision of the Vice Chancellor shall be final.

For remaining 80 marks, there shall be end semester examination conducted by the University. The question paper pattern shall be as below:

1. There shall be questions from each unit.
2. For each unit there shall be 16 marks that shall be apportioned as under:
 - a. 10 marks for essay answer- part (a) of the question.
 - b. 6 marks for short answer or problem question- Part (b)
3. Each Unit shall have two essay questions and two short answer / problem questions of which the student shall answer one each.

With reference to the above subject, the following is brought to the information to Principal of all Affiliated Law Colleges of the Karnataka State Law University:

1. The English Paper prescribed as compulsory for those students who have written 3years LL.B. examinations in regional language (Kannada), for the batches enrolled during academic year 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 shall be entirely subject to internal evaluation.
2. Kannada Kali Paper Prescribed for the 5year LL.B. and 3years LL.B. programmes shall be entirely subject to internal evaluation
3. The pattern for internal examination for English Paper prescribed as compulsory for those students who have written 3years LL.B. examinations in regional language (Kannada), Kannada for 3years LL.B. and Kannada Kali for 3year LL.B. and 5years LL.B. Shall be as under:
 - a. Two Tests for 30 marks each.
 - b. Assignment for 20 marks each.
 - c. Viva for 20 marks each.
4. **Coordination Committee:**
 - a. The Coordination Committees constituted by the University shall review the marks allotted by the course teacher.
 - b. The committee shall inspect the marks awarded to various components and make out if objective standards are followed in awarding marks.
 - c. It shall have the power to vary up to 5% of the marks awarded.
 - d. In case the awarding of marks is found to be arbitrary, the same shall be reported to the University, which shall be considered by a committee constituted by the Vice Chancellor, which shall submit its report to the Vice Chancellor. The decision of the Vice Chancellor shall be final.

Preamble:


The internal Assessment policy of Shri Dharmasthala manjunatheshwara Law College aims to organize the internal assessment in a transparent and robust manner in tune with the guidelines of Karnataka state Law University .

The ICC constituted to oversee the internal examination mechanism has taken the following resolutions with regard to the submission of internal assessment marks in order to make the internal examination system more transparent and robust.

1. The institution shall constitute an Internal Co Ordination Committee to oversee the mechanism of internal assessment
2. As per the guidelines of Karnataka State Law University, the faculty members shall award the internal mark to the students in the following manner

Internal Assessment Test :	10 marks
Assignments :	05 marks
Presentations :	05 marks

3. The faculty shall not disclose the internal marks to the students except the marks scored in the internal assessment test. However, as per the latest circular of the affiliating university, the internal assessment marks shall be displayed in the college notice board for the students' information.
4. After the conclusion of the internal Assessment test, evaluation of assignment scripts and presentation, each faculty shall award the marks to students out of 20.

5. Faculty members are advised not to award out of out marks to any students. However, if any student is awarded with full marks, the concerned faculty shall be called by the ICC for necessary justification and documents.
6. Each faculty is required to submit the marks to the panel constituted for the purpose by the ICC
7. During the submission of marks the following steps shall be followed by the faculty:
8. Each faculty shall submit the marks to the panel on the stipulated date in the given format and get it approved by the panel
9. The ICC authorizes the panel members to seek explanation from the faculty as per SL.No. 4
10. After getting the approval from the panel, each faculty with the assistance of administrative staff should enter the marks to the KSLU portal
11. The faculty members shall not entrust the responsibility of entering the marks to other colleagues
12. Immediately after entering, the faculty shall obtain a printed copy of the same
13. The faculty shall sit before the verification panel and scrutinize the printed copy and original mark sheet and get it approved by the panel
14. After getting it approved by the panel, the faculty shall finally upload marks to the KSLU portal
15. The ICC shall constitute the panel for a tenure of 05 years

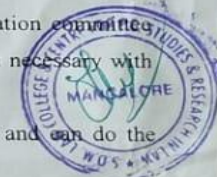

5. The college will be providing a separate score sheet book to the individual classes. All teachers are required to enter particulars of score and get the signature of the student on the final scores secured by him / her and also place their signature.

7. The college will appoint Internal Assessment Redressal Committee consisting of HOD's of departments, Vice Principal and two senior teachers to attend problems relating to mistakes in the evaluation. The committee shall after pursuing the records shall moderate marks not exceeding 15% marks allotted by the course teacher. All proceedings of internal co-ordination committee shall be final. The internal co-ordination committee may seek the assistance of experts from other departments as and when necessary with the prior permission of the Principal.
8. Students can write tests/assignments in Kannada except for languages and can do the presentation also in Kannada.



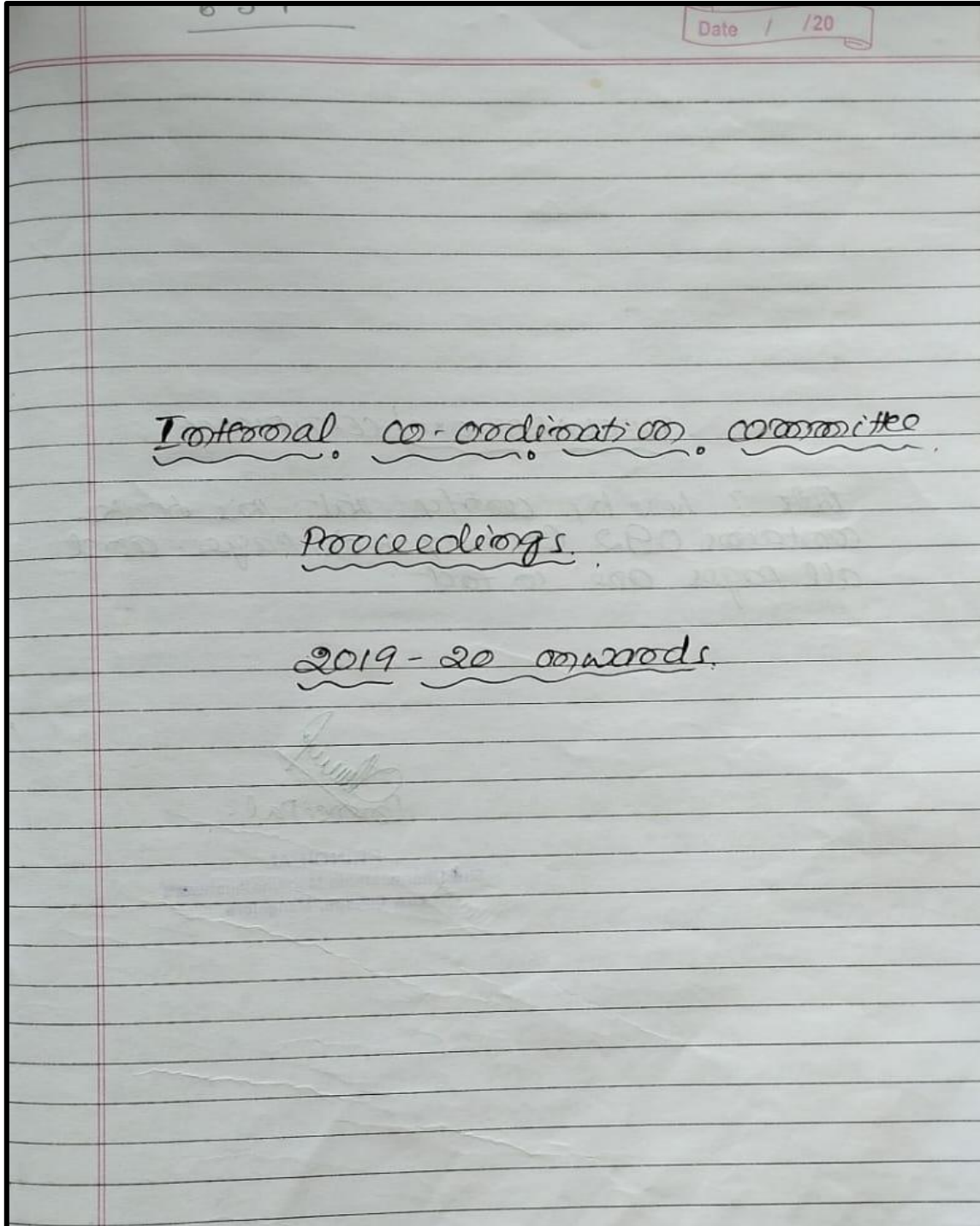

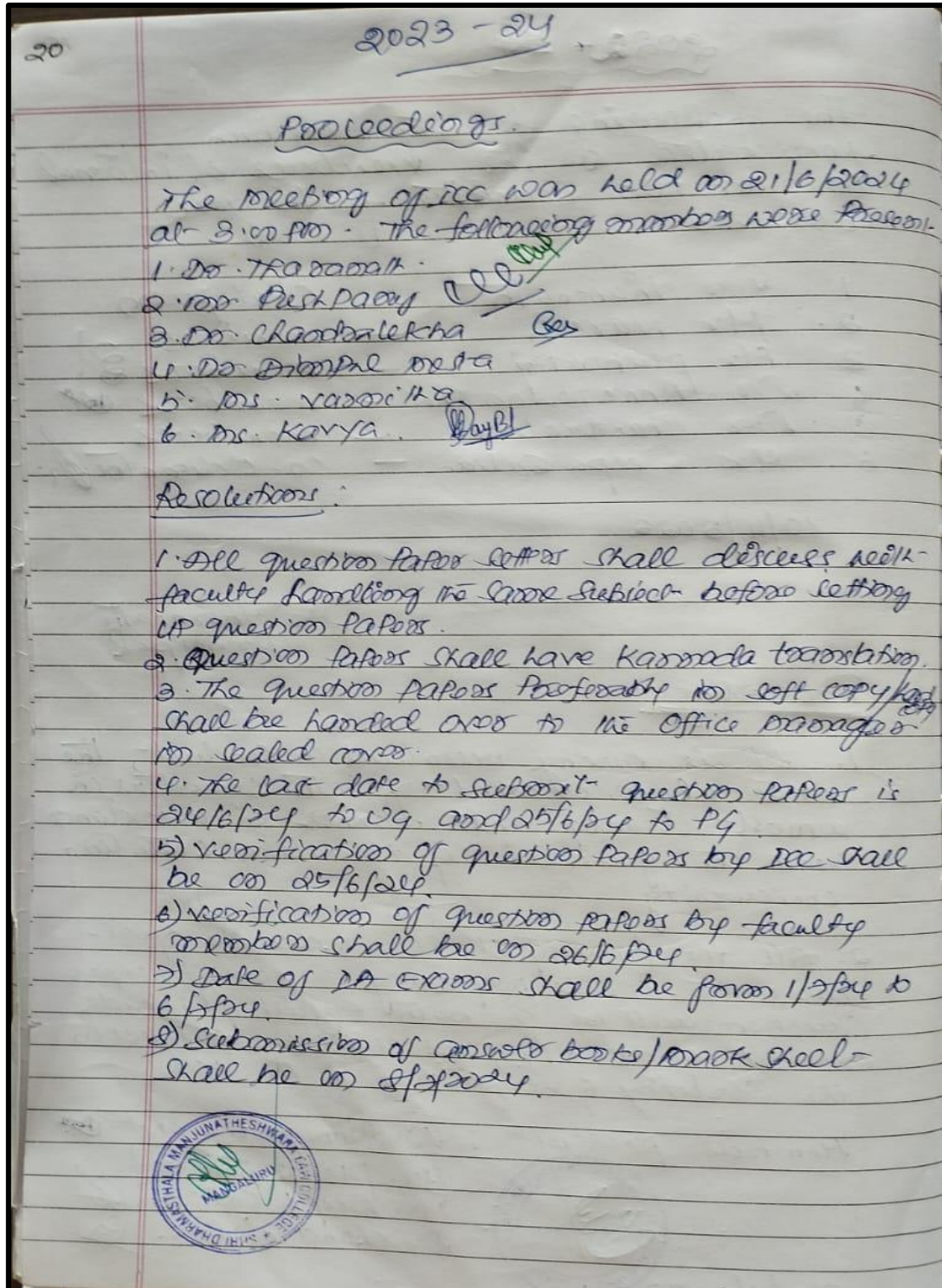

POLICY FOR ADVANCED AND SLOW LEARNERS

Preamble:

The policy for advanced and slow learners of Shri Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwara Law College aims to identify the learning level of students and to evolve mechanisms thereof.

Mechanisms for identification / classification:

The following mechanisms shall be followed to identify the leaning level of students and to categorize them as advanced and slow learners.

1. Admission interview by the panel of experts.
2. Internal Assessment which includes written test, assignment and presentations.
3. Performance in Moot activities.
4. Performance in semester examinations.

Classification of learners:

The classification of student as advanced and slow learners shall not be exclusively based on the performance in examinations. Co-curricular exercises like Moot Court, Mock trial, simulation shall also be considered for the same. Therefore the classification shall be purely subjective in nature.

Policy for the advanced learners:

1. Advanced learners shall be given with additional library cards and books.
2. Advanced learners shall be considered as academic mentors to the slow learners.

Policy for slow learners:

1. Slow learners shall be given with additional library cards and library books.
2. Slow learners should be given academic counselling if needed.
3. Remedial classes shall be engaged for the slow learners for academic improvement.
4. Slow learners shall be encouraged to involve more in co-curricular activities.
5. Slow learners shall be made to avail academic mentoring from the advanced learners.



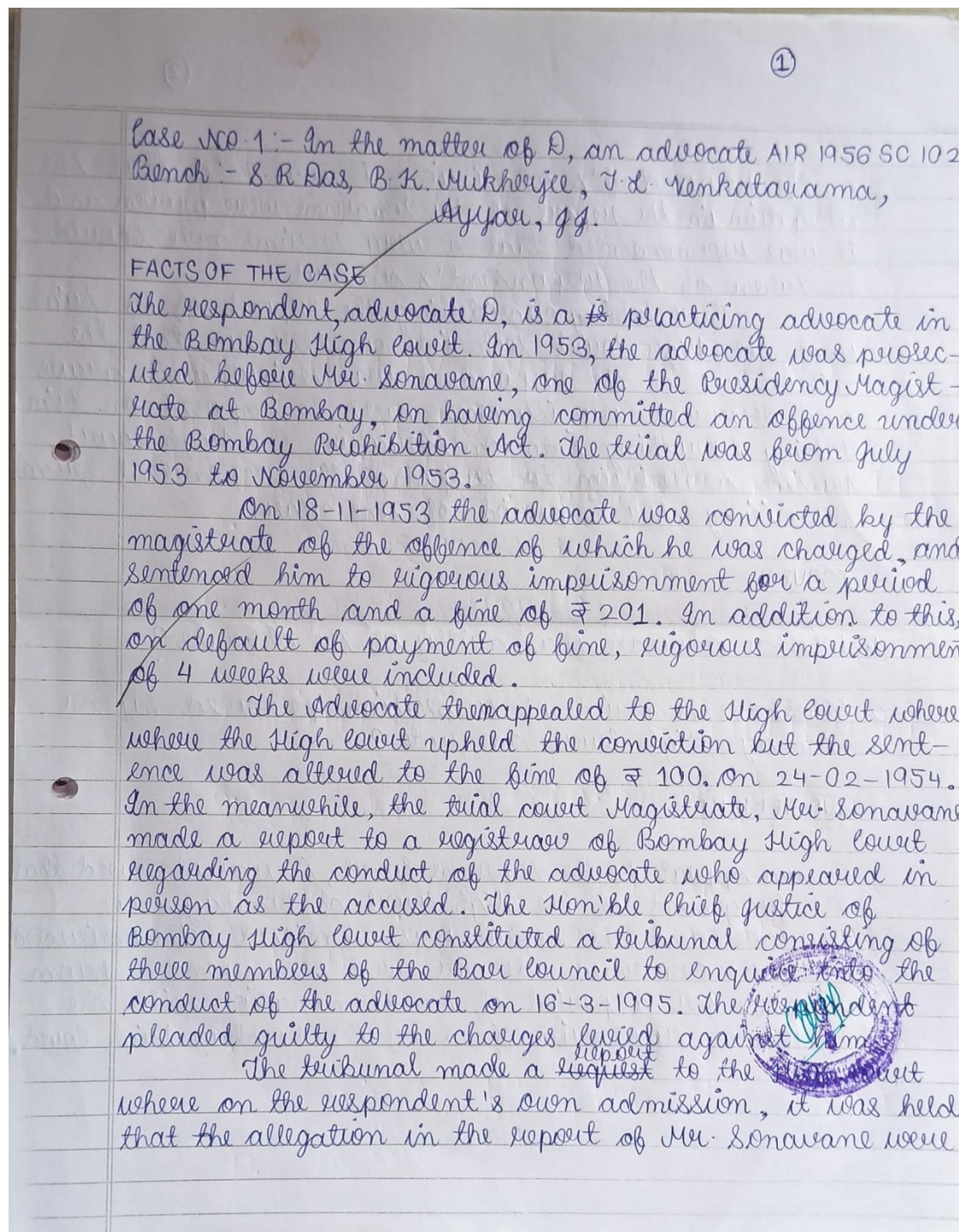

REASONS FOR JUDGEMENT-

1. The conduct of the advocate in the criminal trial against him in the court of magistrate was entirely improper by any standard. It disclosed a continuous attempt on the part of the advocate to be rude to and contemptuous of the Magistrate to hold up the trial and to do everything in his power to bring the administration of justice in ~~power~~ contempt, such a conduct merits severe condemnation. The advocate ~~to~~ has indulged into a conduct unworthy of a member of the honourable profession to which he belonged and so he should be suspended from practice for the same time.
2. Being an advocate of the Supreme Court and entitled under the Supreme Court Advocates Act to exercise his profession in all courts in India any suspension for a period less than fixed by the Bombay High Court would lead to inconvenience. Hence, the advocate was suspended for a period of 60-days with the period of suspension fixed by the Bombay High Court.
3. The advocate pleaded guilty and admitted the correctness of the report against him by the magistrate. He also tendered an unconditional apology to the tribunal evidently in the hope that he would get away with it by merely tendering an apology.

The Supreme Court agreed with the observation of the Bombay High Court and the report of the Advocate General. It was observed that all the above mentioned reasons were correct and upheld the judgement of the

Thus in the view of the conduct of the advocate, I support the opinion of the Supreme Court to suspend the advocate from practice. I also agree with the justification provided by the Hon'ble Court to uphold the period fixed by the Bombay High Court for the suspension as the advocate was entitled to practice his profession in any court throughout the Union of India and any period lesser would be irregular in nature.

FACTS OF THE CASE

Mr. Prashanth is the owner of the property situated in the heart of Mangaluru city. He entered into an agreement to sell the said property with one Mrs. Sakshi for ₹ 83 lacs. Immediately, ₹ 12 lacs was paid as earnest money by Mrs. Sakshi and failed to pay the remaining amount within the stipulated time mentioned in the agreement. Mr. Prashanth alleged that the opposite party failed to pay the rest of the amount towards the sale consideration and the transaction was abandoned. The Respondent Mrs. Sakshi invoked the arbitration clause [which was mentioned in agreement of sale] and requested for appointing arbitrators to settle the dispute.





ARBITRATION CLAUSE (Mentioned in Sale Agreement)

- 15) That any dispute or difference between the parties shall be referred to an arbitration proceedings conducted as per Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. There will be 3 Arbitrators and who shall be appointed by the parties and venue of Arbitration shall be SDM Law College, MG Road, Mangalore
- 16) That the arbitrators shall have no power to conduct class, consolidated or representative action, including any action in the capacity of the private attorney general, and not combine the individual proceeding with other proceeding, without the consent of both the parties. Relief can be granted only on behalf of individual parties and only to the extent of ~~the~~^{their} claims.

PRISON VISIT REPORT

All the 3 final students of SOM college was given an opportunity to visit and observe the administration of the District Prison, Kodialbail, Mangalore on 25th of August 2022 from 12:45 PM to 2:30 PM under the guidance of respected lecturers.

The visit was systematically structured and students were divided into rows. Students were allowed to enter the jail only after verifying the names and college ID card. Each student was inspected and the gadgets were not allowed inside the prison.

Later we were taken to the mock cell which is an abandoned jail from the British time. and they made us to sit in a hall and the resource person who is Shri. obalshappa, Superintendent District Prison, Mangaluru.

In this session, Sir B.T. obalshappa briefed about the prison administration and Adv. Shukraaj Kottary sir spoke few words about the law field and also the administration of prison. Adv. Shukraaj Kottary is a member of District legal authority of Mangalore and he has about 18 years of experience. Prison is a place of accommodation for the people who have committed a case and are undergoing trial for the commission.

Sir spoke about what and all medical facilities are available for inmates. If any of the inmates feel

sick the jail authorities will take the particular inmate to hospital. the doctor will diagnose the patient and will prescribe the tablets. and she also spoke about the food habits which is provided for inmates. the Govt of Karnataka provides two kind of diet to every lodged in the prisons. there will be 7 different food system in seven different days. and every day there will be different types of breakfast daily. However there is a chance for all the inmates to prepare their own food.

She also told about the daily routine of inmates that is inmates should wake up before sunrise and around 7 o'clock, breakfast will be provided after that the inmates will be left free for their own work. some of the inmates will be working in the prison and they get remuneration of Rs. 150 each daily and for the skilled inmates the remuneration is of Rs. 170.

And some other non interested inmates they have indoor games such as carrom, chess to play and there is also television to watch movies and programmes. 10:30 AM there will be meals for the inmates, and around 5 o'clock they provide dinner will be provided, before sunset all the inmates should be there in their respective rooms and authority will lock every room.

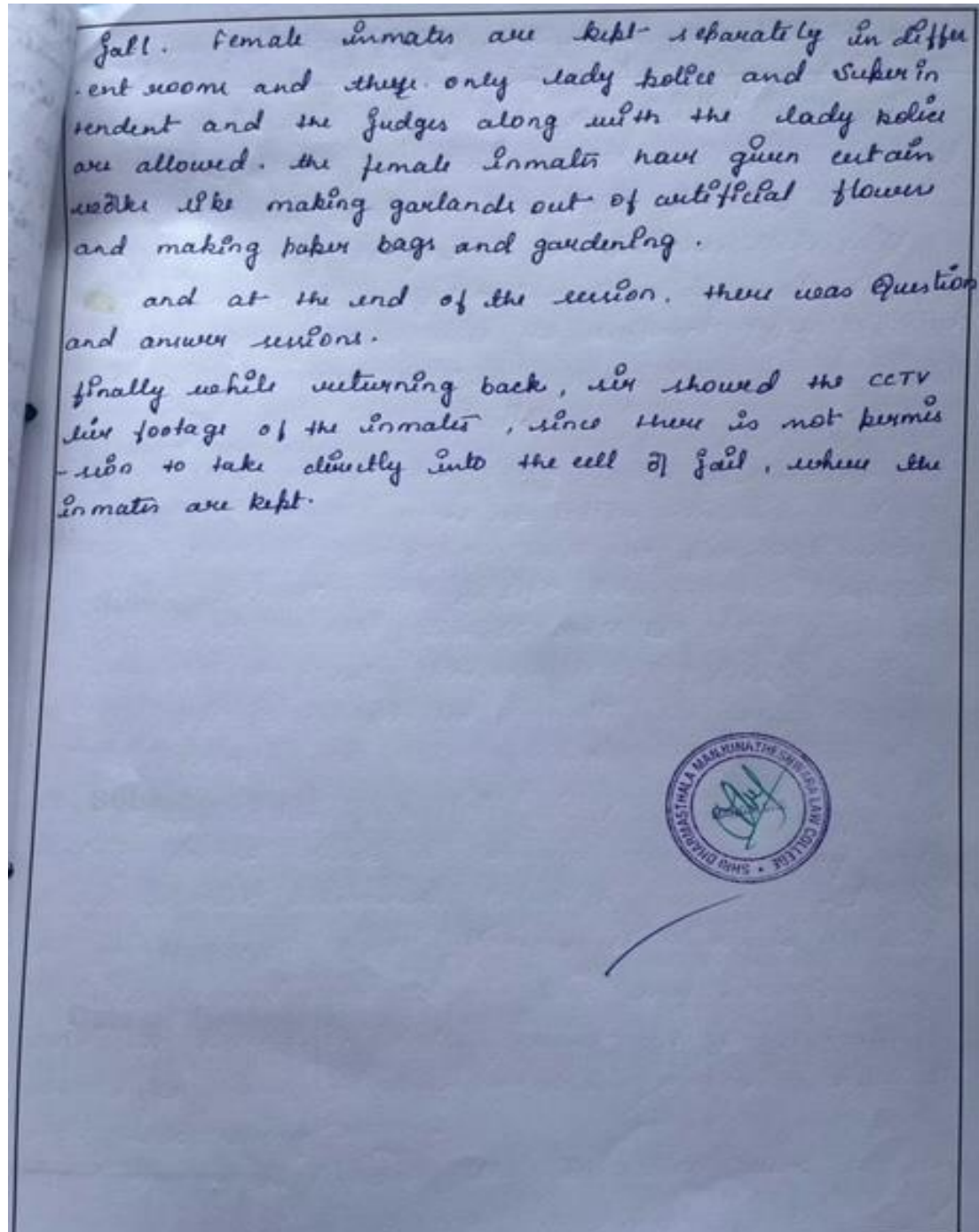

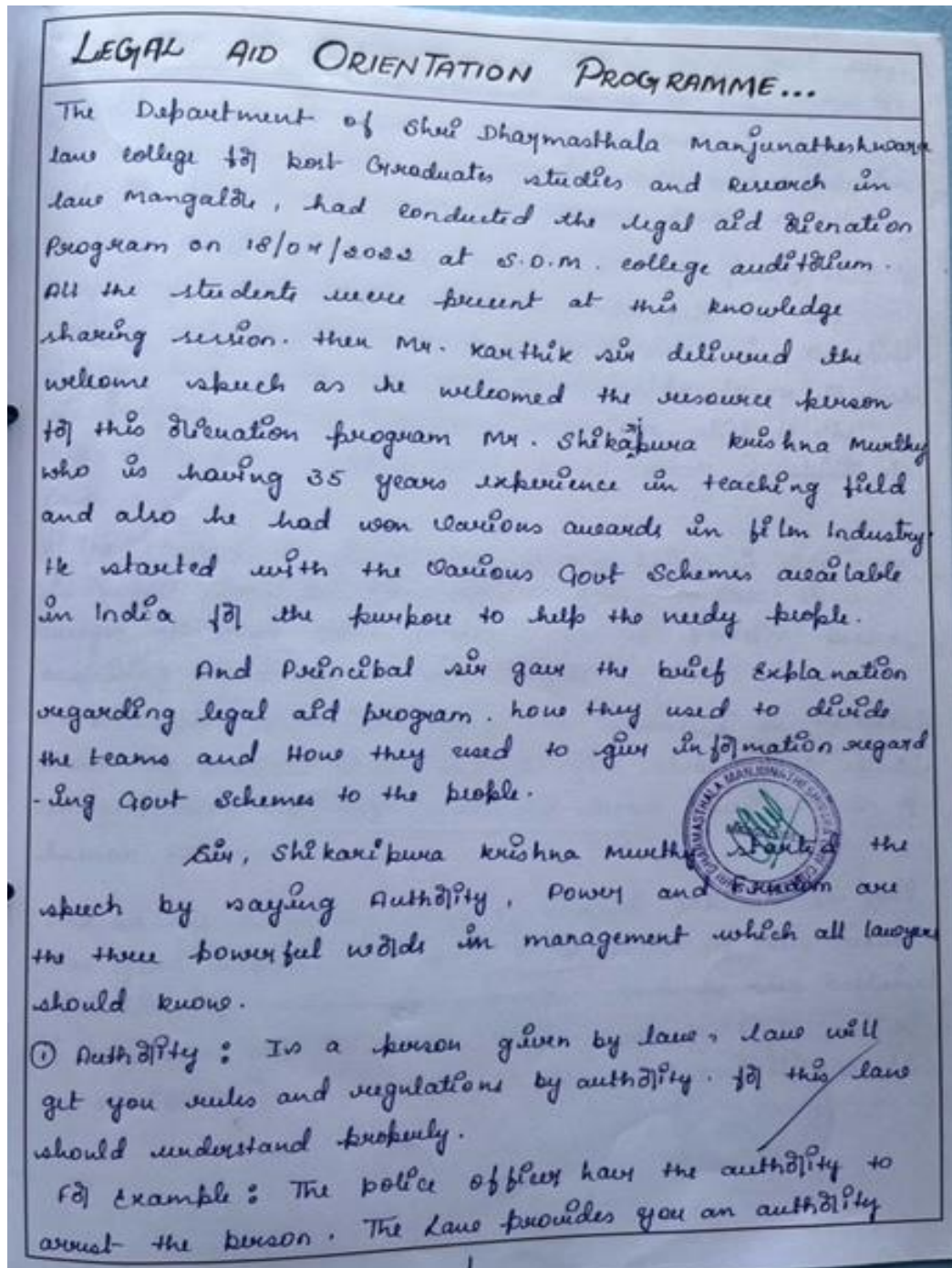

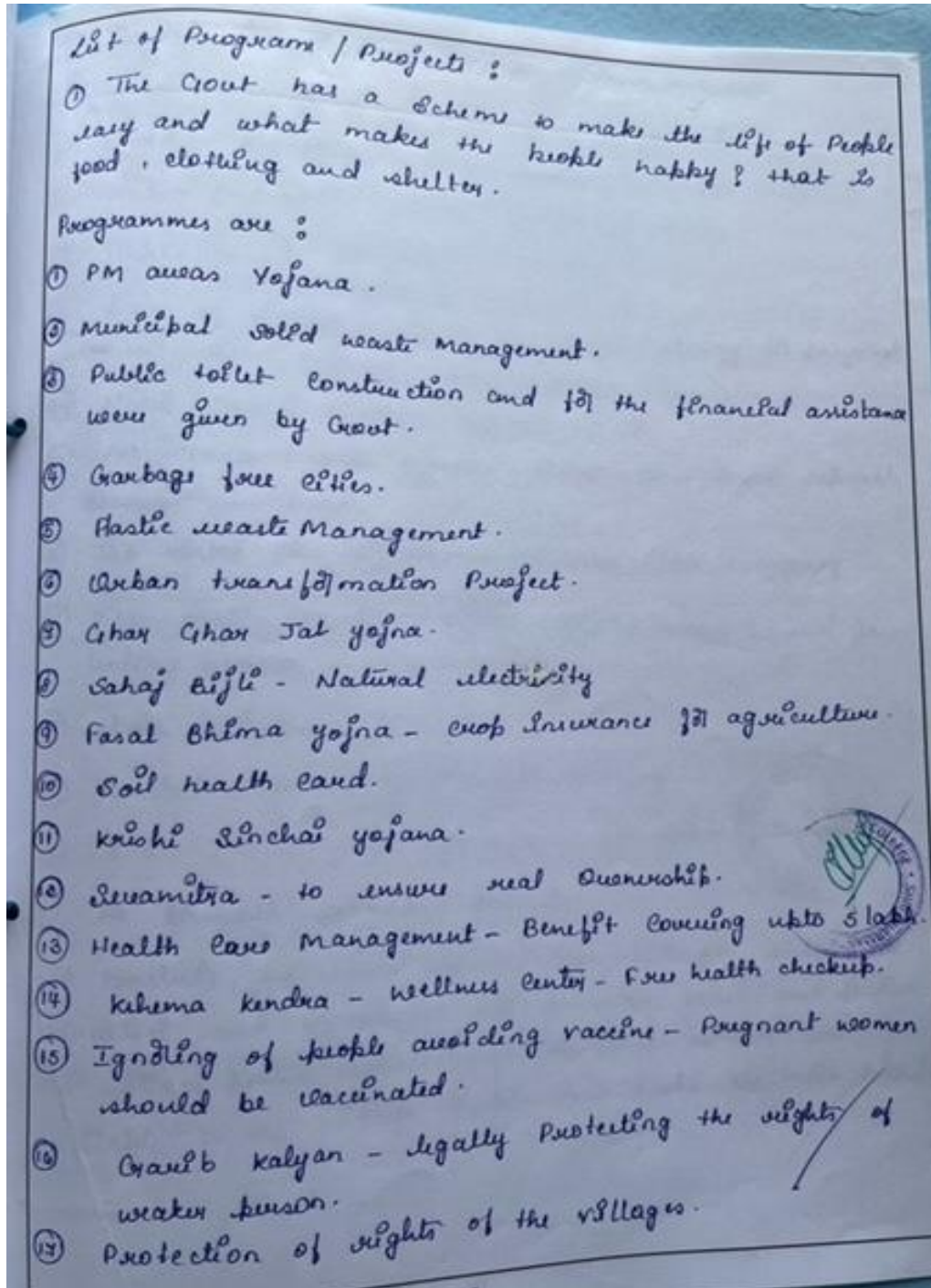
