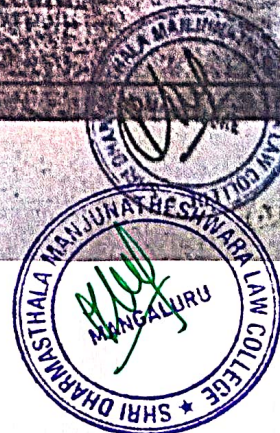

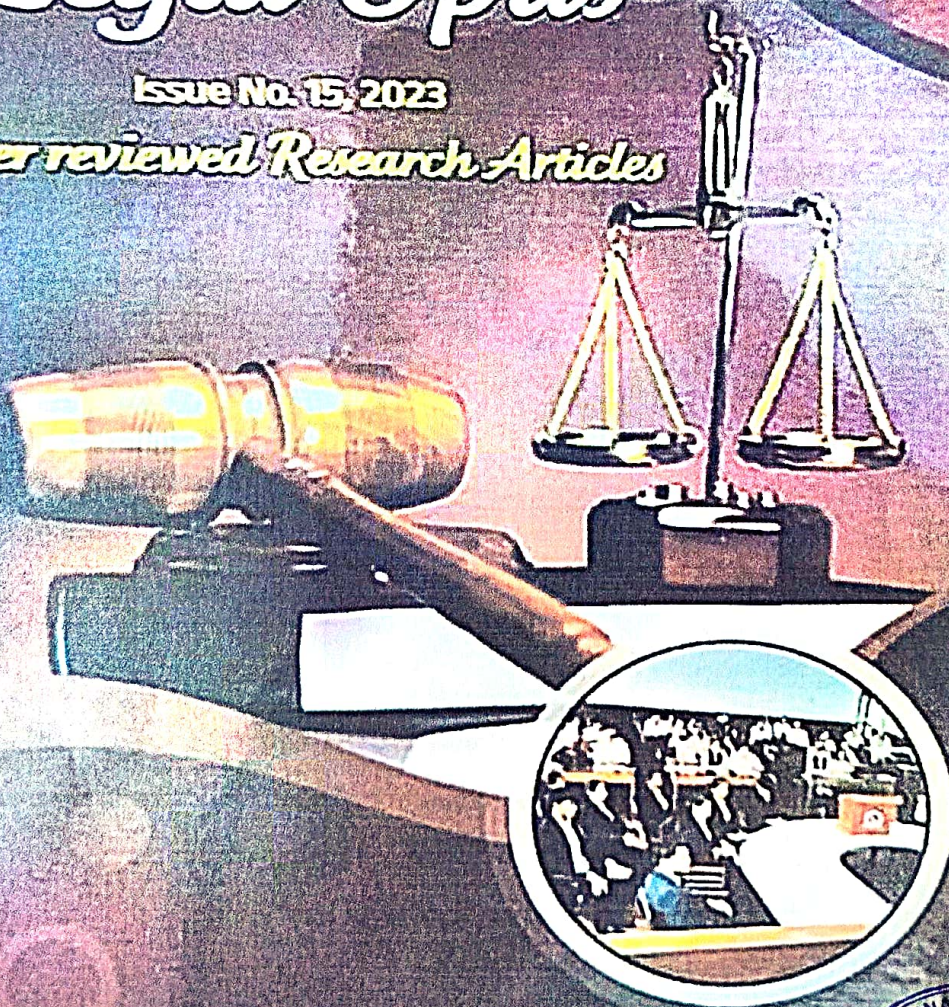

The programme was organized by the Entrepreneurship Development Cell of the college.

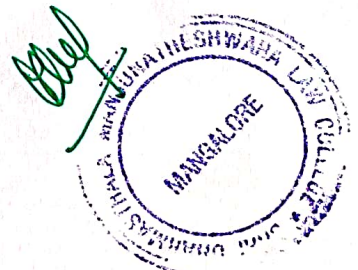
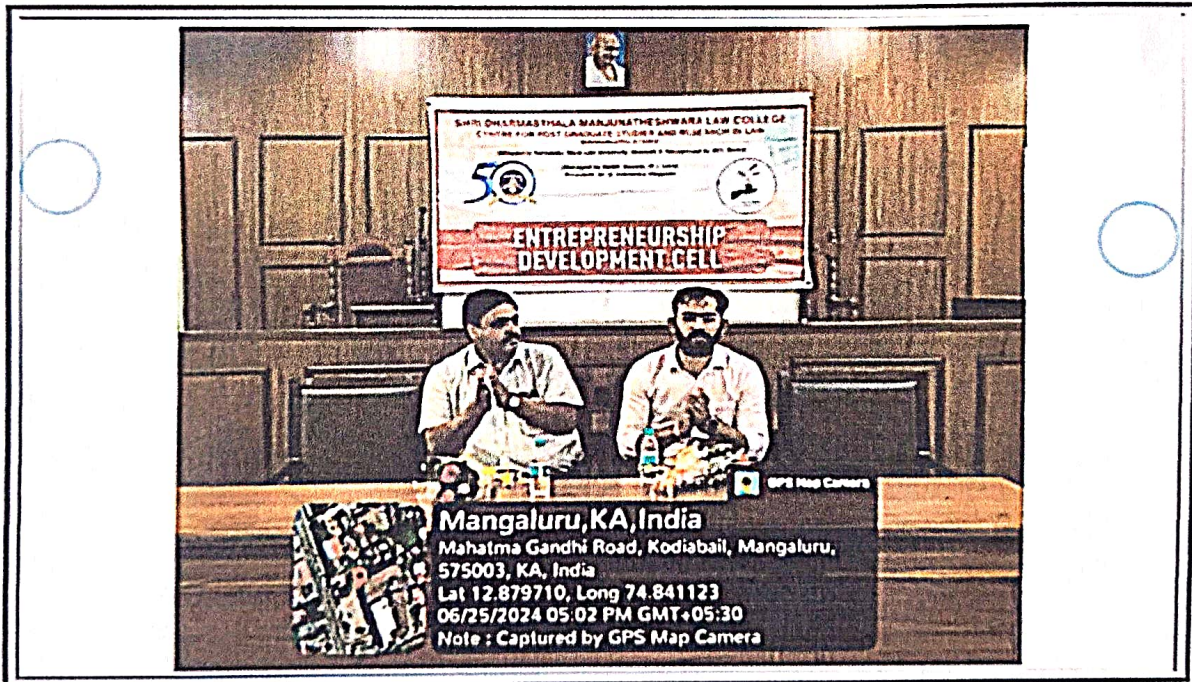
