GENERAL MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) FOR ACADEMIC AND
RESEARCH COOPERATION BETWEEN

MANIPAL ACADEMY OF HIGHER EDUCATION, MANIPAL
AND
SHREE DHARMASTHALAMANJUNATHESHWARA LAW COLLEGE,
CENTRE FOR POST GRADUATE STUDIES & RESEARCH IN LAW, MANGALORE, D.K.

The Manipal Academy of Higher Education, deemed-to-be-University under Section 3 of UGC Act, 1956, Manipal and Shree Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwara Law College Centre for Post Graduate Studies and Research in Law, Mangalore, establish this General Agreement to foster cooperation in education and research.

1. Both parties agree to encourage the following activities, in particular to promote academic cooperation:
 - a. Exchange of materials in education and research, publications, and academic information;
 - b. Exchange of faculty and research scholars;
 - c. Exchange of students;
 - d. Joint research and meetings for education and research;
 - e. Technical assistance;

Both parties shall discuss the problems involved to the satisfaction of each party and enter into specific activity agreements based on the mutually agreed objectives and outcomes of the relationship.

2. This General Agreement shall be applicable to educational and research organizations attached to each party.
3. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties, and all prior discussions, agreements and understandings, whether verbal or in writing, is merged in this agreement.
4. This Agreement is not considered to be a contract creating legal and financial relationships between the parties. Rather, it is designed to facilitate and develop a genuine and mutually beneficial exchange process/research relationship and so forth.
5. This General Agreement shall become effective as on 01-05-2023 and executed on 01-05-2023. The Agreement may be amended by the written consent of the parties.
6. This Agreement should be reviewed every five years to evaluate the progress and the quality of the mutual cooperation. The Agreement may be extended for additional five year periods upon the written consent of both parties. If the Agreement is not renewed by mutual consent, the Agreement will conclude at the end of the specified time period or after activities in progress have concluded.



7. This Agreement may be terminated by either party with a minimum of 120 days written notice. Activities in progress at the time of termination of this Agreement shall be permitted to conclude as planned unless otherwise agreed.
8. Both institutions subscribe to a policy of equal opportunity and do not discriminate on the basis of race, color, gender, age, height, weight, marital or familial status, ethnicity, religion national origin or disability.
9. All disputes or difference arising between the parties as to the affect, validity or interpretation of this MOU or as to their rights, duties or liabilities shall be resolved by mutual discussion between representatives of Manipal Academy of Higher Education, Manipal and Shree Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwara Law College Centre for Post Graduate Studies and Research in Law, Mangalore
10. Neither Manipal Academy of Higher Education, Manipal nor Shree Dharmasthala Manjunatheshwara Law College Centre for Post Graduate Studies and Research in Law, Mangalore will be held responsible for any liability to the other party, and neither party shall be required to purchase any Insurance against loss or damage to any property due to activities to which agreement relates.

Each party shall designate a person or office to serve as liaison for implementing the projects undertaken as per this Agreement.

Every collaboration will have its own agreement/contract which addresses issues such as publications, IPR, funding pattern, disclosure of information etc. This has to be based on the mutual discussion and agreement finalized by the concerned people involved in it.

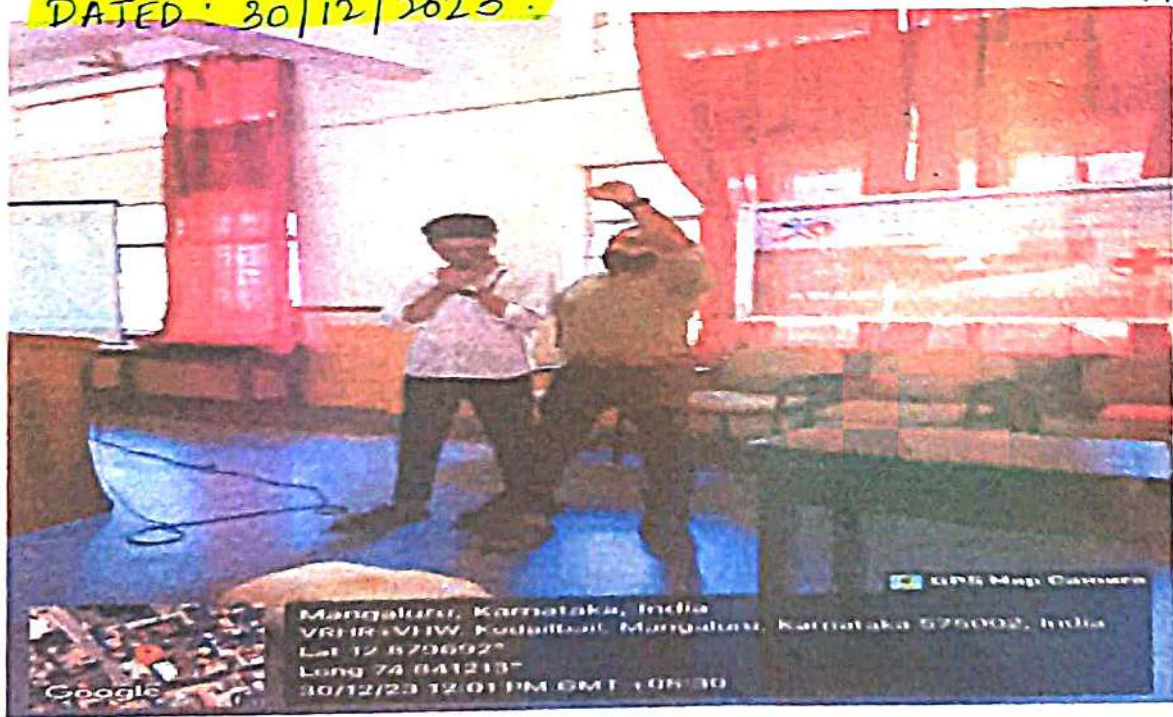

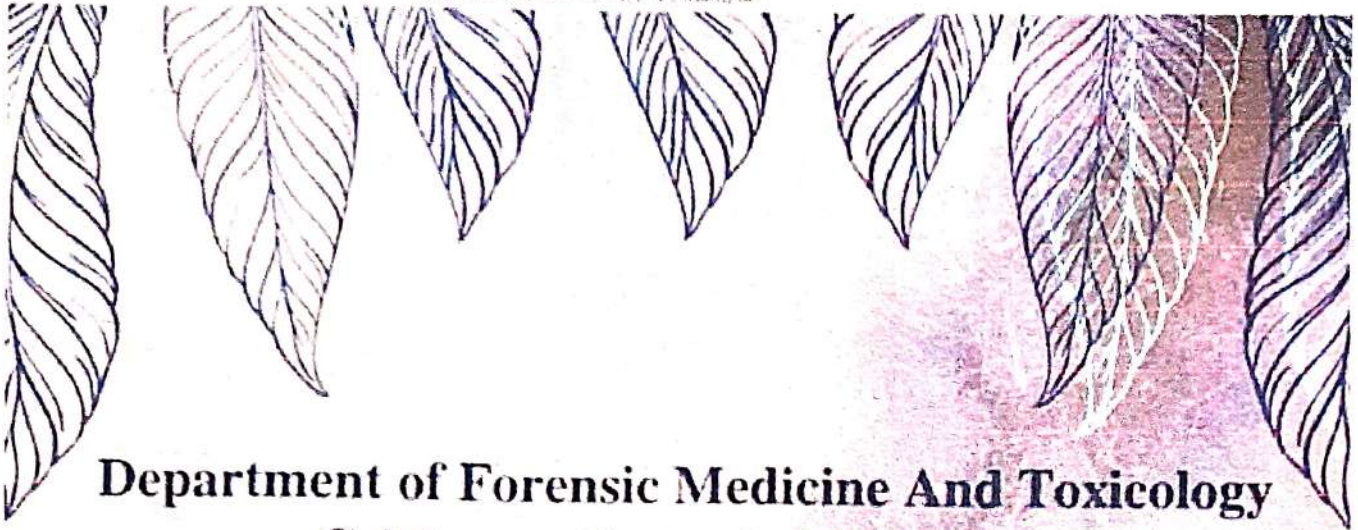

The students who attended the orientation program gave their positive response on the presentation of guest lecture.



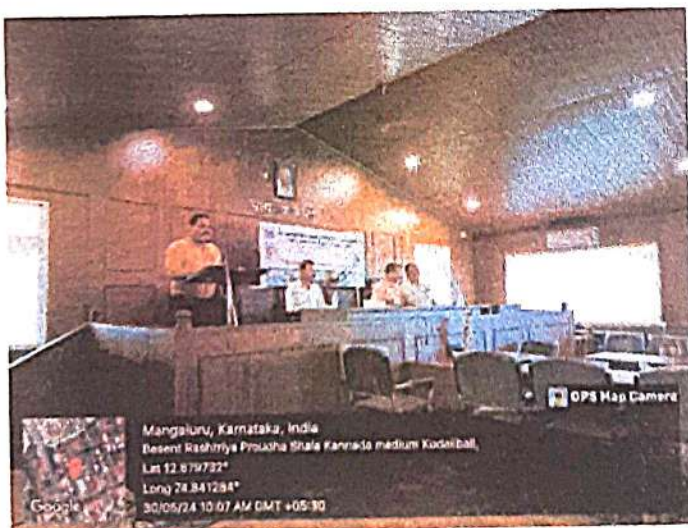

(5) Amendments

Any change, alteration, amendment or modification to this MOU must be in writing and signed by authorized representatives of both parties.

(6) Duration

This MOU shall become effective upon signature by the authorized officials from SDMLC and is valid for 2 years from the date of signing the MOU unless modified or terminated by any one of the partners by mutual consent.

(7) Financial Commitments

The Parties mutually acknowledge that each company's financial profits resulting from their respective business operations, or services shall remain entirely independent and exclusive to the respective company. Neither Party shall have any right, title, or interest in the financial profits or revenues generated by the other Party, except as explicitly agreed upon in the individual project agreements.

(8) Term and Termination

This MOU shall commence upon signing by both the parties and continue for a standard duration until either party terminates this agreement in writing. In any case of termination issue, both parties hold the authority to cancel this agreement by conducting a mutual discussion with the board of directors and by giving a month's notice in writing. Upon such termination, the agent shall cease marketing and offering service or information and shall waive any rights to continue sharing, with any third party of the UNIABROAD's confidential information.

6. Students, faculty staff/members, designated officials and members of both the institute/organisation are welcome to make use of the library resources of each other and to have academic interaction with the each other;

7. Designated persons and officials from both the organisation will hold meetings for the purpose of planning activities from time to time and will explore possibility of taking up collaborative projects and also apply for funding from national and international agencies, governments and other funding agencies;



Any financial implication emerging out of such collaborations shall be worked out and decisions will be taken with mutual agreement.

B. AREAS OF COOPERATION:

This Memorandum expresses a mutual desire by SDMLC and ABAP cooperates in building intellectual and research capacity and scholarship. Additional areas of co-operation may be added by written consent of the two the parties. Both parties will act in good faith to ensure that the objectives in this Memorandum are realized.

C. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

Progress in realizing the terms and conditions referred to herein will be reviewed periodically as mutually agreed and the memorandum may be amended at any time by mutual consent and in writing. Both parties reserve the right to terminate this memorandum by either party by giving six months written notice to the other. The implementation and/or continuance of programmes or projects established pursuant to this memorandum prior to the effective date of termination shall not be affected by the termination of this Memorandum.

D. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND CONFIDENTIALITY

1. In respect of each project and programme of co-operation, the parties shall negotiate and mutually agree in writing on their respective rights to Intellectual property and commercial exploitation of the same (Including without limitation,

2. Neither party shall, at any time disclose to any third party any confidential information of the other party which is acquired in the course of activities under this Memorandum, a collaborative project or a programme, without the prior consent of the other party in writing. The confidentiality obligations herein will not apply to information in the public domain; information in the possession of the receiving party prior to the disclosure of the information; information which is independently developed by the receiving party; information required to be released by law; and information which is rightfully received by the receiving party from third parties without any breach of confidentiality obligations.

E. NON BINDING NATURE OF MEMORANDUM

Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any contract, partnership, agency or other legal relationship between the parties. This Memorandum is only a non-binding statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

F. TERMINATION

1. This memorandum shall come into force immediately upon its signature by the parties.



2. The validity of this Memorandum of Understanding is initially for a period of five years from the date of its execution and the same can be further extended on mutual agreement.

3. This Memorandum of Understanding can be terminated by either of the parties by giving advance notice of six months and without jeopardizing the project work or progress of any such program of either institution.
