Grievance Redressal Policy

Preamble

As per the guidelines of the UGC Grievance Redressal Regulations, 2018 composition of the grievance redressal mechanism is aimed to provide a safe, fair and harmonious environment for learning and personality building of students.

Policy

To keep in check any devious behavior or unreasonable issue that obstructs the smooth learning process and provide subsequent relief after proper deliberation.

Aims and objectives

- 1. The grievance redressal mechanism is an institutional process which is a formalized method to accept, access and resolve complaints.
- 2. The aim is to encourage the students to express their grievances freely in order to build a conducive environment for learning.
- 3. The grievance policy ensures that the process by which problems and concerns are addressed shall be fair, unbiased and within the purview of the rules and regulations formulated in the college calendar.
- 4. Any complaint shall be resolved within the shortest period of time in order not to disturb the academic environment of the learners.

Procedure of lodging complaint

- 1. The students can lodge complaints directly or indirectly.
- 2. The complaint can be lodged by a written letter to the chairman of the grievance redressal committee or by email or even by a phone call provided that the written submission should be made prior to the enquiry process.
- 3. The complaint should be duly signed by the complainant for an action to be taken there on.
- 4. The students can drop a note in writing in the suggestion box and such grieve be addressed looking at the genuineness of the complaint.

Composition of the Grievance Redressal Committee

- 1. Ex-officio Chairman Principal
- 2. Chairman Vice principal
- 3. Member HOD Law
- 4. Member HOD Humanities
- 5. Convenor Student Welfare Officer

Procedure for resolving complaint

- 1. Review of the complaint will be done by the committee members.
- 2. The committee will assess whether the complaint is academic or non academic.
- 3. If the complaint is academic in nature the HOD's are directed to look into the issues and take necessary action to resolve the same.
- 4. Non academic problems will be addressed looking into the nature of the complaint.
- 5. Students will be called to orally present their standpoint.
- 6. The committee will ensure that confidentiality will be maintained so that students can speak freely without fear.
- 7. The matter will be resolved as quickly as possible. If required parents will be called to educate them about certain issues.
- 8. If necessary students will be advised to attend sessions with the counselor.

Preamble

In pursuance to the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 8–5–2009 in civil Appeal No. 887/2009, the UGC framed "UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational Institutions, 2009" which were notified on 17th June 2009, as per the UGC guidelines SDM Law College has structured Anti-Ragging Cell. College ensures that a congenial and welcoming environment is given to all the students. To achieve this objective the following committee has been formed by the Institute as per UGC Regulation 2009.

Introduction to Anti-Ragging Cell (ARC)

Ragging is considered a sadistic thrill, and it is a violation of Human Rights. Ragging is totally prohibited in SDM Law College, inside and / or outside the campus and anyone found guilty of ragging and / or abetting ragging whether actively or passively, or being a part of conspiracy to promote ragging, is liable to be punished in accordance with UGC Regulations 2009 as well as under the provisions of any penal law for the time being in force.

The Anti-Ragging Committee will be the Supervisory and Advisory Committee in preserving a Culture of Ragging Free Environment in the college Campus. The Anti-Ragging Squad- office bearers will work under the Supervision of Anti Ragging Committee and to engage in the works of checking places like Campus, Hostels, PG, Buses, Canteens, Classrooms and other places of student congregation. The Anti-Ragging Committee will be involved in designing strategies and action plans for curbing the Menace of Ragging in the college by adopting an array of activities.

Objectives of ARC

Ragging is a humiliating social crime. The foremost objectives of ARC are:

- To prevent and protect the student community from being ragged or indulging in the act of ragging
- To bring awareness among the students about the ill effects of ragging, its impact on human life and consequences of involvement in the act of ragging
- To set up a monitoring system comprising of Anti Ragging Squad (ARS) to vigil
 the on campus and off campus situations to eliminate the chances of ragging
 cases
- To receive the complaints and resolve them through the ARC
- To initiate legal actions when required considering the intensity of ragging instances in case occur

What constitutes Ragging

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student;
- Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student;
- Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the

ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student;

- Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
- Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students;
- Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, posts, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student;
- Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

Roles and Responsibilities

Chairman

- To ensure compliance with the provision of UGC Regulation on Anti-ragging at the institution level
- To monitor and oversee the performance of an Anti-Ragging squad in prevention of ragging in the institution.
- To take appropriate action in case an incident of ragging is reported by the Anti- Ragging Squad of the institute and to further inform/get approval of action to be taken from the University Anti-Ragging Committee.

Convenors

- Devise mechanism for receiving, processing and addressing all information regarding incidence of ragging.
- Devise and promote a credible anti-ragging policy in college.
- Advise Disciplinary Committee and subcommittees on new policies or directives on handling cases of ragging (as applicable) from time to time.
- Sensitization of employees towards cases of ragging.
- Seek advice of expert to handle complicated grievance cases related to ragging apart from advise by other committee(s) if need arises.
- Compile/ submit biannual basis, the grievance summary report (on cases related to ragging) if any along with recommendations.
- Maintain all records, statements, actions and other correspondences related to ragging cases.

Anti Ragging Squad

Formation

Mobile squads shall be formed from time to time for every year to facilitate, keeping and upholding the objectives of the Committee. The Squad so formed shall be with the approval of the chairman and known only to ARC.

Roles

- > The Anti-ragging squad is formed to oversee the implementation of the recommendations of the anti-ragging committee.
- ☐ The Anti-Ragging Squad shall be maintaining vigil, oversight and patrolling functions and shall remain mobile, alert and active at all times in the campus.
- ☐ In any case of ragging sighted, the situation shall be secured, reported to the Anti- Ragging Cell for further course of actions

Duties of Ragging Grievant or Witness

Ragging is a very prohibited and punishable offense by law. If any ragging instances take place, then the following guidelines will help you,

- 1. Do not panic or get scared, start walking towards principal's office
- 2. Do not abuse back or try to answer or to settle the issue on spot
- 3. Immediate help could be requested from any of the Anti-Ragging Cell (ARC) members or SDM Law College staff members who are found in the nearest distance
- 4. If ragging is observed by a third person then the same may be immediately brought to the notice of any of the Anti-Ragging Cell (ARC) members or SDMLC staff members for help in the nearest distance
- 5. A written complaint has to be submitted to the Anti-Ragging Cell (ARC) describing the ragging instance completely with date, time and place of happening
- 6. The complaint should contain the identity of the complainant and the identity of the alleged
- 7. The complainant should submit the complaint in person to any of the Anti-Ragging Cell (ARC) members
- 8. The confidentiality of the complainant and any other applicable issues shall be maintained

Redressal of Ragging Cases

In case of any ragging case reported

- If the ragging instance is reported to be in occurrence, then the Anti-Ragging Cell
 (ARC) members shall immediately arrange for securing the complainant and/or
 victim
- 2. The victim should be taken for counseling
- 3. A written complaint shall be received from the complainant and/or victim describing the full details instance, date, time and place of occurrence
- 4. The complainant's and/or victim's identity such as name, branch, semester, section, contact number, e-mail id, parent's name, parent's contact shall be obtained
- 5. The allege d's identity such as name, branch, semester, section, contact number, e-mail id, parent's name, parent's contact shall be obtained
- 6. The complaint shall be documented in the file with member secretary
- 7. The complaint shall be brought to the notice of the chairman
- 8. A hearing shall be held in consultation with the chairman to resolve the issue to decide upon the action
- 9. The actions against the alleged if found guilty shall be recommended by the Anti-Ragging Cell (ARC) to the Head of the institution in reference to the recommended actions by the SDM Education Society or the University and Supreme Court orders.

Actions

- The punishment to be meted out to the persons indulged in ragging has to be exemplary and justifiably harsh to act as a deterrent against recurrence of such incidents.
- 2. Every single incident of ragging a First Information Report (FIR) must be filed without exception by the institutional authorities with the local police authorities.
- 3. The Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution shall take an appropriate decision, with regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging.
- 4. Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offense as established the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:-
 - (i) Cancellation of admission
 - (ii) Suspension from attending classes
 - (iii) Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
 - (iv) Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
 - (v) Withholding results
 - (vi) Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
 - (vii) Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
 - (viii) Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters
 - (ix) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.

(x) Collective punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.

POLICY ON PREVENTION OF SEXUAL HARASSMENT (POSH)

Introduction

SDM Law College Centre for Post Graduate Studies and Research in Law is committed to providing a safe and respectful workplace environment for all employees, students and visitors. We believe in fostering a culture that promotes dignity, respect, and equal opportunities for all individuals, free from any form of sexual harassment. This policy outlines our commitment to preventing sexual harassment, defines the responsibilities of all parties involved, and establishes procedures for addressing complaints in a fair and timely manner.

Policy Statement

- 1. Scope: This policy applies to all employees, students and visitors of college. It covers all forms of sexual harassment that occur within the workplace premises, during work-related activities, or at college-sponsored events, whether on-site or off-site.
- 2. **Definition:** Sexual harassment is defined as any unwelcome conduct of a sexual nature, whether verbal, physical, or visual, that creates an intimidating, hostile, or offensive work environment. This includes but is not limited to:
 - Unwanted sexual advances
 - Requests for sexual favours
 - Verbal or physical conduct of a sexual nature
 - Displaying sexually explicit materials
 - Making derogatory comments or jokes of a sexual nature

3. Prohibited Conduct

- Engaging in any form of sexual harassment is strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated.
- Retaliation against any individual who reports sexual harassment or participates in an investigation is also prohibited.

4. Responsibilities

- Management: Outline the responsibilities of college administration in preventing and addressing sexual harassment.
- Employees: Specify the duties of faculty and staff in reporting and responding to incidents.
- Students: Explain students' responsibilities in adhering to the policy and reporting any instances of harassment.

5. Reporting Procedure:

- Any students who experience or witness sexual harassment are encouraged to report it immediately to the internal complaints committee, set up in the college to deal with matters related to sexual harassment.
- Complaints to be given in writing. The college will ensure confidentiality to the extent possible and will conduct a prompt and thorough investigation.
- Internal complaints committee comprises a chairperson who is a female faculty of the college, 2 internal members including a male member and 1 external member.

6. Investigation and Resolution:

- Upon receipt of a complaint, the college will initiate a fair and impartial investigation.
- The investigation will be conducted promptly, respecting the privacy and confidentiality of all parties involved.
- If the investigation confirms that sexual harassment has occurred, prompt and appropriate corrective action will be taken, up to and including termination of employment or suspension of student from the institution.

7. Training and Awareness:

 College will provide regular training and awareness programs to educate employees and students about sexual harassment, prevention strategies, and reporting procedures.

8. Policy Review:

- This policy will be reviewed periodically and updated as necessary to reflect changes in legislation, best practices, or organizational needs.
- Students will be notified of any updates to the policy and expected to adhere to the revised guidelines.

Implementation

This policy is effective immediately upon approval and dissemination to all stakeholders of the institution. All students are expected to familiarize themselves with this policy and adhere to its guidelines.
