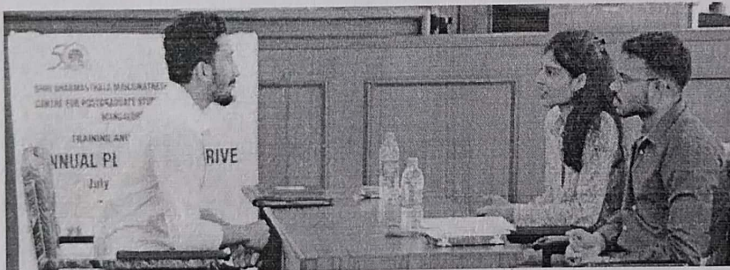
## AIMS AND OBJECTIVES:
